

Objective: To determine whether the student can seek and use information effectively and responsibly.

Criteria	Yes/Somewhat/No
1. Defined the information needed in the paper or poster's introduction, taking into account the parameters of the assignment.	
2. Found information that meets requirements of the assignment. Kinds of sources in the Works Cited match what was in the assignment, demonstrating that the student understood where to search and which kinds of sources to use.	
3. Found credible sources – articles from library databases or journals, images, books, media, open access materials or web resources that pass the CRAAP test.	
4. Found information that serves the purpose of the paper by providing background information or definitions, exhibiting information (including art and literature) that the paper or presentation analyzes or interprets, presenting evidence in support of an argument or its opposing view, or explaining a method of researching or interpreting information.	
5. Cited sources in the body of the paper and in a Works Cited list.	

Instructions for raters:

Yes means all the sources in the student paper or presentation met the criteria.

Somewhat means some met the criteria and some did not. Please add specific notes, in the box or on the back of this sheet, explaining which criteria was only met "somewhat" and why.

No means none of the sources met the criteria.
