



RIVIER UNIVERSITY IMMUNIZATION POLICY

All resident and commuter students (both part time and full time) must document and present the following immunizations to Rivier University Health Services prior to August 15 (for fall admittance) or January 15 (for spring admittance).

- 2 doses of Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) or a positive MMR titer; an equivocal titer is considered negative
- Tdap within the last 10 years
- 3 doses of Hepatitis B or a positive Hepatitis B titer
- Meningitis A (Menactra or Menveo at age 16 or later)
- Meningitis B at age 16 or within 2 years of residency
- Proof of 2 doses of Varicella Vaccine or a Varicella titer
- Titers must show positive immunization; equivocal is not accepted.
- Negative TB Skin Test within the last year prior to the first day of classes when required

Rivier University will consider a request for exemption only for the following:

Medical Necessity/Contraindication

You must submit Rivier University's Request for Immunization Exemption form signed by your medical provider and notarized. If the student is over 18, this form must be signed by the student.

Religious Objection

You must submit a notarized copy of Rivier University's Request for Immunization Exemption form. If the student is over 18, the waiver must be signed by the student.

Quarantine Policy

In the case of an outbreak on campus for which students are not immunized as required by the University, the student will be required to leave campus until the New Hampshire Department of Health determines it is safe for the student to return. If the student is quarantined from campus, the student is not eligible for tuition, room, or board refunds and may suffer academic consequences if class or lab attendance is necessary to meet course requirements.
