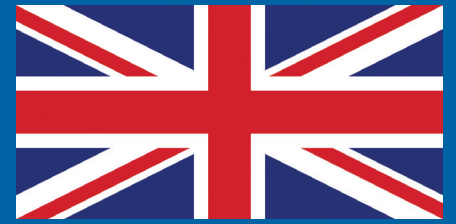

Starting at the near-millennium-old Tower of London, you'll track the evolution of the British legal system, exploring from the inside of the Royal Courts of Justice, the Inns of Court and the Old Bailey, perhaps recognizable from *A Tale of Two Cities* or "Law & Order."
