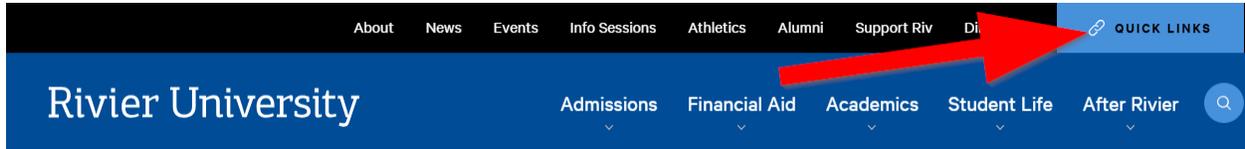
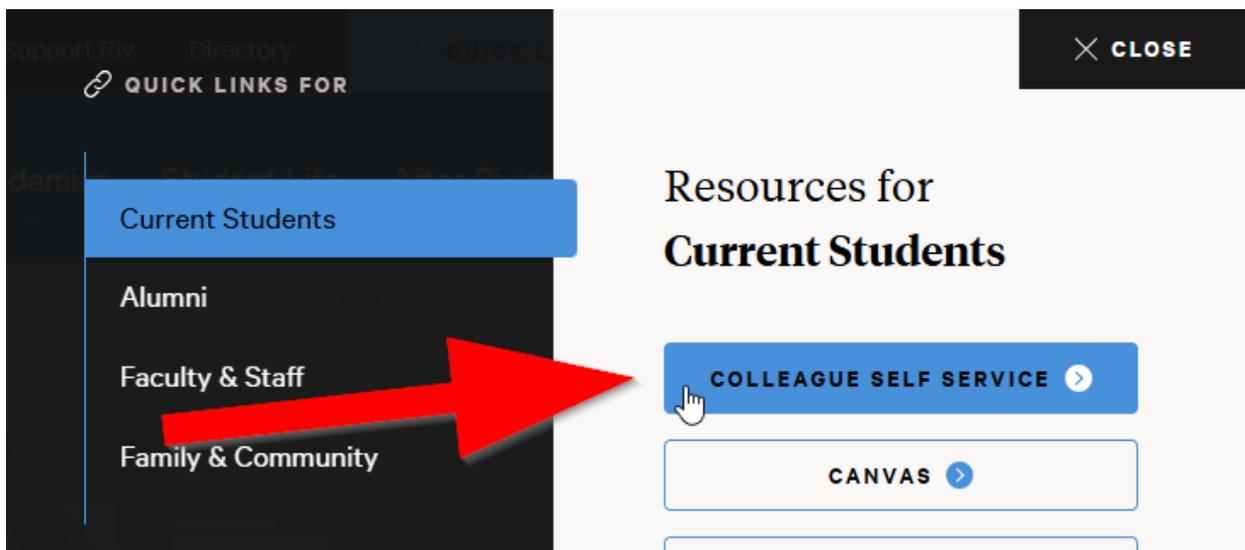


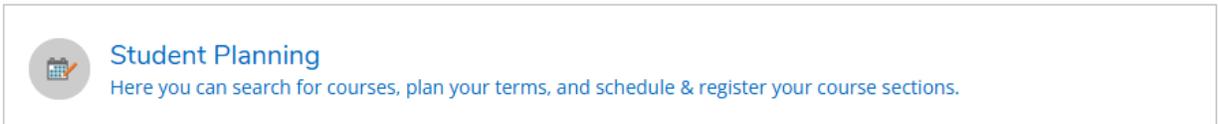
Register for Classes in Colleague Self-Service



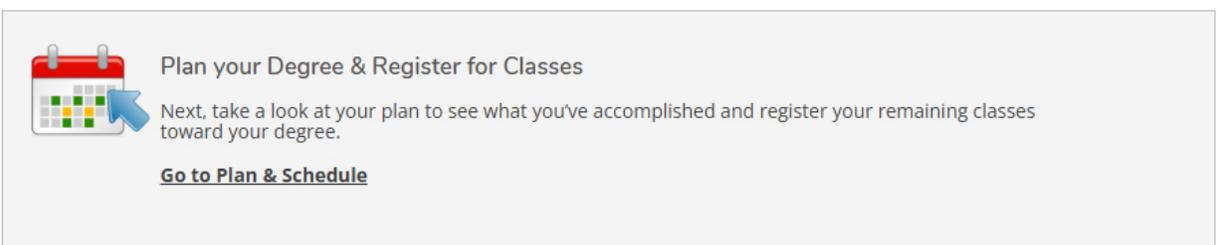
1. Access Colleague Self-Service using the “Quick Links” section on the University website.



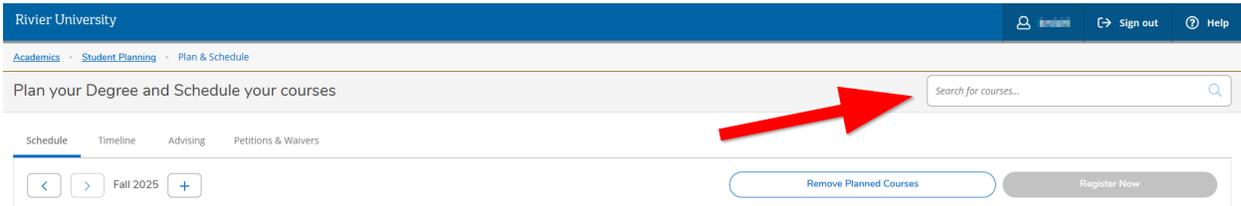
2. Sign in using your Rivier single sign-on credentials.



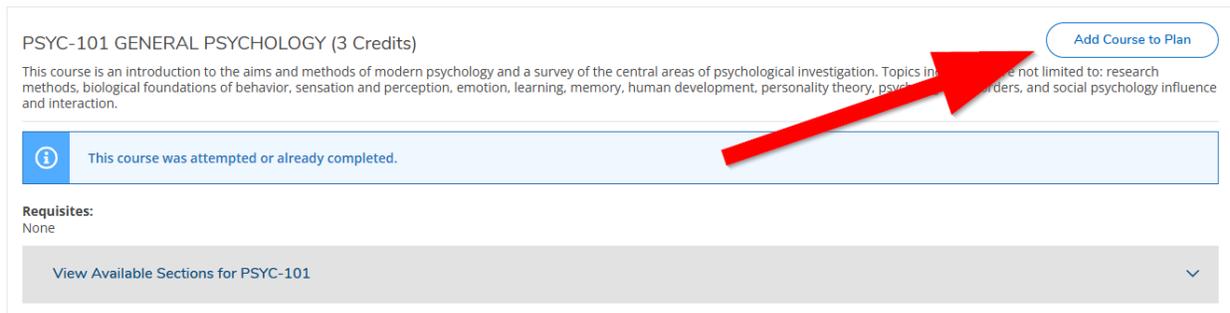
3. From the main menu of Colleague Self-Service, select “Student Planning” to search for courses, plan terms, and register.
