The U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics projects rapid growth in green jobs through 2030, yet many of these positions remain unfilled due to a shortage of qualified candidates. Rivier's Environmental Studies and Sustainability major fills this gap by preparing students for impactful careers in policy, education, and advocacy—fields that are increasingly vital in shaping a sustainable future. Rooted in the University's mission and social teaching, the program emphasizes stewardship of the environment as an essential moral responsibility.
