EMPLOYMENT PROMISE PROGRAM

Rivier University provides the academic rigor, active learning experiences, community service, leadership and internship opportunities to fully prepare students for meaningful employment.

Confidence in the quality of a Rivier education enables the University to ensure invested students will secure employment within nine months of graduation. If not, the University will provide additional support to its graduates.

Students who enroll in the Employment Promise Program (EPP) will receive career investment goals, and must actively participate in career development opportunities as part of their overall educational experience.

CAREER INVESTMENT GOALS

Each EPP student receives a unique career investment plan customized to their individual strengths and career goals. Plans include academic, leadership, professional development, and service experiences to enhance career preparation and employability.

THE PROMISE

If students meet their career investment goals and are not employed in their field within nine months of graduation, the University will either make their monthly federal subsidized student loan payments for up to a year or enroll graduates in a Rivier master's degree program, tuition-free.



➤ Graduates who are unemployed nine months after graduation may elect either of the following:

FEDERAL LOAN REPAYMENT

Rivier will make the graduate's monthly federal subsidized student loan payments for up to 12 months.

or

TUITION-FREE GRADUATE STUDY

Graduates may enroll in up to six graduate courses at Rivier, tuition-free.

➤ Graduates who are employed in an unrelated field not requiring a college degree may enroll in up to six graduate courses at Rivier, tuition-free.

STUDENT ENROLLMENT AND ELIGIBILITY

Program Enrollment

Students enroll in the program by reviewing and signing the Employment Promise Program agreement prior to the start of their freshman year.

Eligibility for Promise Fulfillment

- Students must graduate from Rivier with a bachelor's degree, a minimum 3.0 cumulative grade-point average, and at least 60 completed undergraduate credits.
- Students must be in good standing with the University, including conduct, and have met their financial obligations. They must not carry a financial balance while enrolled at Rivier, except with an authorized payment plan.
- Within 30 days of graduation, EPP students not employed full-time within their field of study (or a similar discipline) must schedule a meeting with an Office of Career and Life Success staff member and continue to meet monthly until employment is secured. Meetings may take place in person, by phone, or virtually.
- Students must be legally eligible for employment in the United States.
