According to the National Institute of Mental Health, mental illnesses affect tens of millions of people annually. However, estimates are that 50% of those affected do not receive treatment. While several factors contribute to the lack of treatment, the shortage of clinicians and their inequitable distribution across the U.S. are major contributors.

Make a Difference

Rivier's Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner (PMHNP) program qualifies you to assess, diagnose, and treat the mental health needs of patients across the lifespan. PMHNPs prescribe medication and administer psychotherapy as part of their patients' treatment plans. Most PMHNPs maintain their own medical practices, but some work under the supervision of a physician according to individual state guidelines. With proper treatment, fewer patients risk homelessness, incarceration, violent episodes, victimization, and suicide.

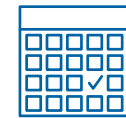
