Rivier has one of the largest pre-licensure undergraduate nursing programs in New Hampshire and has been a regional leader in education for more than 30 years. In addition to coursework, Rivier's state-of-the-art Simulation Labs offer a wide range of interactive learning experiences.

### Gain Real-World Experience

Clinicals, faculty-led global health service trips, and co-curricular experiences build your skills as well as knowledge. Clinical nursing courses may include one or two clinical days or one 12-hour day at hospitals and facilities generally within 60 miles of the University.

Study abroad opportunities to complement coursework with service in another country. On-campus events allow students to gain greater exposure and understanding of nursing practice and patient populations.

Rivier graduates had a 93.81% NCLEX first-time pass rate from 2020-23 versus the national average pass rate of 84.38%. Once graduates pass the exam and receive their RN credential, they may enjoy careers as, but not limited to:

- Community/public health nurses
- Hospice nurses
