A.S. IN CRIMINAL JUSTICE to B.S. IN CRIMINAL JUSTICE

Beginning with the 2013-2014 academic year, a graduate of NHTI - Concord's Community College, who meets the following requirements and satisfactorily completes the following requirements for admission will be automatically accepted for admission and receive junior-class standing in the Liberal Arts and Sciences Division at Rivier University for the Bachelor of Science degree program in Criminal Justice:

- Completes the requirements of the Criminal Justice major as listed in the current NHTI Concord's Community College catalog, and;
- Receives the Associate in Science degree with a minimum of a C (2.0) grade point average.
- Submits application for transfer to the Admissions Office at Rivier University.
- Accompanies application for transfer admission with a \$25 non-refundable fee.
- Indicates Transfer Articulation Program (TAP) on transfer application.
- Submits a complete official transcript from NHTI Concord's Community College.

Students who transfer through the Transfer Articulation Program are generally able to complete their remaining requirements for the baccalaureate degree in two more years of full-time study. Advising material is included with this agreement and early academic advising is strongly recommended.

Entrance Requirements for all students include submission of a Writing Sample, an institutional assessment tool, which is administered to all new students, including students who transfer through the Transfer Articulation Program. Credits earned for ENG101 English Composition I will be accepted for transfer; however, course placement (whether fulfilling the requirement, ENG120 College Composition I, and/or a general elective) will be determined individually upon completion of the Writing Sample and recommendations submitted by department faculty.

In addition, transfer students must have earned a 2.5 or better in any course which they seek to transfer as the equivalent of a C.J. major course at Rivier University. This includes not only C.J. courses, but also related science, history and social science courses, which are required to earn a Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice at Rivier.

This agreement, effective 2013-2014 academic year, will be ongoing. This agreement is subject to catalog and/or program revisions at both institutions; however, this agreement will continue to apply to students who transfer from the NHTI – Concord's Community College Criminal Justice program should this agreement be cancelled.
