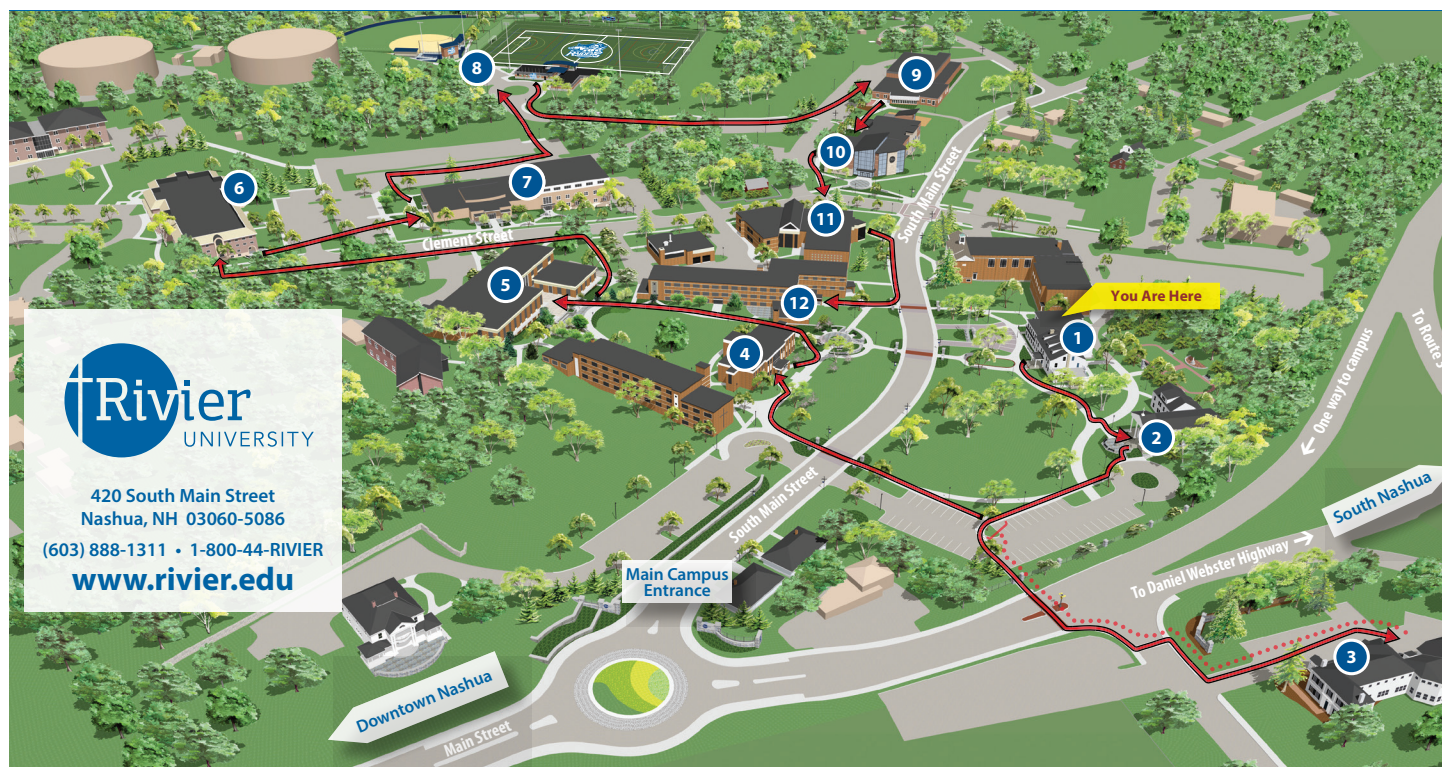


Please enjoy this self-guided tour of the top 12 spots on campus!



1. Madeleine Hall

First stop: Madeleine Hall. Here you will find the Admissions Offices for both our Undergraduate and Graduate programs. Whether you are a first-time, transfer, or returning student—we're here to help you through the admissions process.

2. Resurrection Chapel

Founded by the Sisters of the Presentation of Mary and Sister Madeleine of Jesus in 1933, Rivier University is a private four-year, Catholic institution that welcomes students from all backgrounds.

3. Learning Commons

The Learning Commons houses student support services such as the Academic Support Center, Counseling and Wellness, Disability Services, and Academic and Career Advising.

4. Adrienne Hall

Here you will find Academic Affairs, the Registrar, and Student Financial Services. Each student is assigned a financial aid advisor to help answer questions and provide guidance. Discover our history in Heritage Plaza on your way to stop 5.

5. Dion Center

In Dion Center you will find Student Affairs, Public Safety and Security, Campus Ministry, the dining center, our bookstore, and offices and gathering spaces that support the student experience.

6. Benoit Education Center

Benoit Education Center is home to classrooms, and the Cho Educational Resource Center, which offers a unique collection of materials that support students in the majors of Education and Counseling.

7. Sylvia Trottier Hall

Here you will find our Nursing SIM Labs, the McLean Center for Finance and Economics, a Cybersecurity Lab, our information technology and faculty offices, and classrooms.

8. Joanne Merrill Field, Linda Robinson Pavilion, and Raider Diamond

Student athletes take notice! Linda Robinson Pavilion elevates the game-day experience for athletes and fans. Joanne Merrill Field is a turf field, directly behind the Pavilion. Raider Diamond, the University's softball field and team dugouts, is to the left.

9. Muldoon Fitness Center

The Center provides indoor space for basketball, indoor soccer, volleyball, and floor hockey. It also features locker rooms and a fully equipped gym open to all.

10. Science and Innovation Center

The Science and Innovation Center is a 35,000 square-foot facility that encompasses state-of-the-art labs, collaborative spaces for research, and technology that support students in our Science and Healthcare Programs.

11. Regina Library

Regina Library provides resources and services to foster academic excellence in the Rivier University community. Here, you can access thousands of print volumes, eBooks, and journals.

12. Guild Hall

Guild Hall is home to most first-year students. It is a social environment, making it the perfect community for anyone new to college! There are free laundry facilities, a lounge with a pool table, vending machines, and a full kitchen.
