1. Madeleine Hall

2. Resurrection Chapel

Founded by the Sisters of the Presentation of Mary and Sister Madeleine of Jesus in1933, Rivier University is a private four-year, Catholic institution that welcomes students from all backgrounds.

3. Learning Commons

The Learning Commons houses student support services such as the Academic Support Center, Counseling and Wellness, Disability Services, and Academic and Career Advising.

4. Adrienne Hall

10. Science and Innovation Center


