

## TRANSFER ARTICULATION PROGRAM MIDDLESEX COMMUNITY COLLEGE and RIVIER UNIVERSITY A.S. NURSING to RN-BSN NURSING PROGRAM (ONLINE)

Programs Accredited by the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing

Beginning with the 2019-2020 academic year, the Division of Nursing at Rivier University agrees to accept into its RN-BSN Nursing Program (ONLINE) registered nurses who have graduated from Middlesex Community College Associate Degree Program in Nursing with a minimum grade-point average of 2.5 (C+) and who satisfactorily complete the following requirements for admission:

- Submit application for transfer to the Admissions Office at Rivier University;
- Apply for Financial Aid through Rivier University's Financial Aid office, if eligible;
- Submit a complete official transcript from Middlesex Community College;
- Submit evidence of licensure (required of all new associate degree graduates before beginning RN-BSN Nursing Program (ONLINE) courses).

A written notification of transfer admission will be mailed to each applicant by the Admissions Office. Middlesex Community College graduates transferring to Rivier University through this articulation agreement may complete their remaining requirements for the baccalaureate degree in two years full-time, or four to six years part-time study in a flexible online environment.

This agreement, effective the 2019-2020 academic year, will be ongoing. This agreement is subject to catalog and/or program revisions at both institutions; however, should this agreement be terminated, students who transfer from the Middlesex Community College Nursing program within one year of the termination of this agreement will be accepted under the terms of this agreement.

Both Colleges agree to the right to use each other's names in print and media advertising to the public for the purpose of marketing the programs described herein.

## Middlesex Community College Nursing Program

## And

### RIVIER UNIVERSITY

The purpose of the Early Admissions Option is to simplify the process allowing nursing students matriculated in the Associate of Science Degree in Nursing Program at Middlesex Community College to enroll in the RN-BSN Nursing Program (ONLINE) at Rivier University.

The following changes regarding the process of enrollment into Rivier University are in effect:

- 1. Students interested in matriculating in the RN-BSN Nursing Program (ONLINE) at Rivier University shall complete the *Early Admission Application* and submit one copy to the community college nursing program office and one copy to the Admissions Office at Rivier University, 420 South Main Street, Nashua, NH 03060.
- 2. Students may submit the Early Admission Application at any time during their education program at Middlesex Community College.
- 3. The Early Admission Application will be submitted to the community college registrar. A final transcript listing courses completed and graduation date will be forwarded to Rivier University.
- 4. The RN-BSN Success Coach or Academic & Career Advisor will contact students who submit an Early Admission Application to the Rivier University nursing office, in order to design an education plan for meeting the baccalaureate degree requirements.
- 5. Students may enroll in Rivier University general education courses before completing the associate degree and before completing the registered nurse licensure process without applying for admission. They may enroll in selected courses at Rivier University with the approval of the Rivier University RN-BSN Success Coach or Academic & Career Advisor prior to completing all requirements for the associate degree. However, once 12 credits have been taken at Rivier University, students must complete the admissions process and be matriculated to continue their education at the school. Students must complete a minimum of 30 credits of the RN-BSN Nursing Program (ONLINE) at Rivier University in order to receive their baccalaureate degree in Nursing.
- 6. Students wishing to matriculate will be responsible for submitting a *Rivier University Application* and transcripts from all colleges attended, and sending them directly to the Admissions Office at Rivier University.
- 7. All other premises of the Articulation Agreement between Middlesex Community College and Rivier University remain as originally stated.



# TRANSFER ARTICULATION PROGRAM MIDDLESEX COMMUNITY COLLEGE and RIVIER UNIVERSITY A.S. IN NURSING to 3 + 1 OPTION: RN-BSN NURSING PROGRAM (ONLINE)

Programs Accredited by the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing

The purpose of the **3+1 Option** is to provide a seamless transition in education for nursing students transferring from Middlesex Community College into the RN-BSN Nursing Program (ONLINE) at Rivier University. Students utilizing this option are eligible to transfer a maximum of 90 undergraduate credits into the RN-BSN Nursing Program (ONLINE) from Middlesex Community College. All transfer students must earn a minimum of 30 credits from Rivier University before a bachelor's degree will be conferred. These credits must fulfill course requirements over and above the course requirements listed under the Associate of Science Degree in Nursing. Registered nurses eligible for this agreement are those who have graduated from Middlesex Community College Associate Degree Program in Nursing with a minimum grade-point average of 2.5 (C+), and who satisfactorily complete the following requirements for admission and transfer:

- Receive a minimum of a B- on all nursing courses and nursing related courses;
- Submit application for transfer to the Admissions Office at Rivier University;
- Submit a complete official transcript from Middlesex Community College;
- Submit evidence of licensure (required of all new associate degree graduates before beginning RN-BSN Nursing Program (ONLINE) courses);
- Contact Rivier University's 3+1 Option Success Coach or Academic & Career Advisor at <u>asktheadvisor@rivier.edu</u>, or (603) 897-8227, for guidance in course selection and to develop an individual plan. This process will ensure proper course selection for a seamless transition into Rivier's RN-BSN Nursing Program (ONLINE).

Middlesex Community College graduates transferring to Rivier University through this articulation agreement may complete their remaining requirements for the baccalaureate degree in one year full-time, or two to two-and-a-half years part-time study in a flexible online environment.
