Background

The Samuel A. Tamposi, Sr. Scholarship Fund was established in 1995 through the efforts of the late Sam Tamposi's business associates, family and friends. Sam Tamposi, Sr., a New Hampshire businessman, humanitarian, and former member of the Rivier Board of Trustees, began his successful business career in Nashua, New Hampshire. Throughout his life, he enjoyed success with numerous businesses, finally initiating the development and accumulation of a real estate empire in New Hampshire and Florida.

Sam considered hard work, ingenuity and the desire to achieve essential to personal success. He also recognized the importance of opportunity as an element to this success. Tamposi truly believed that if one member of society advances because of opportunity, the entire community benefits.

The Samuel A. Tamposi, Sr. Scholarship is a competitive award paid over four years of full-time undergraduate day study at Rivier University. Each year, the Scholarship Committee selects deserving recipients from those high school graduates from the greater Nashua community attending Rivier University full-time. In recognition of Mr. Tamposi's alma mater, Nashua High School, one recipient must be a graduate of Nashua High School.

The Tamposi Scholarship is paid in eight semester installments of equal amounts over four years of undergraduate day study. Renewal of the scholarship is based on continuous full-time enrollment at Rivier University and maintenance of at least a 3.0 cumulative grade point average (GPA).
