Honestly, I am stuck between teleportation and telekinesis... in either scenario I will be lazy and use my power to travel and for miscellaneous tasks.

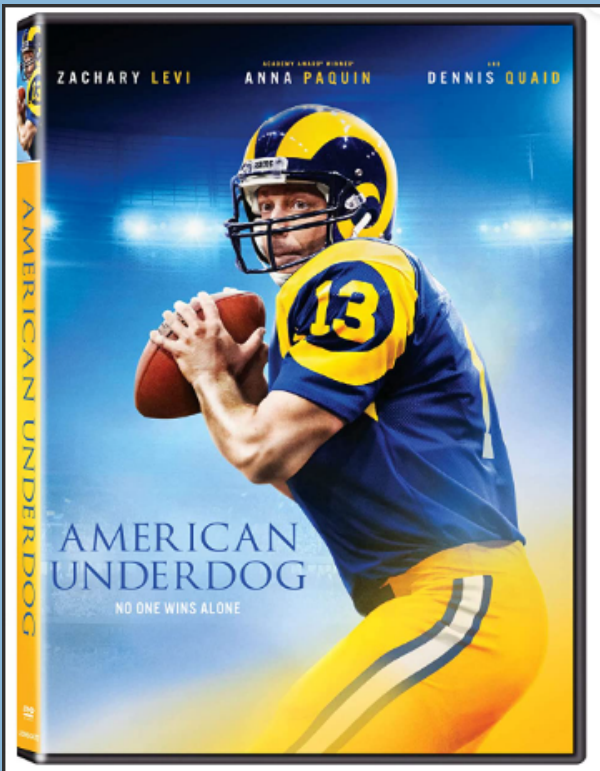
What do you do to turn things around when you're having a bad day?
