Regina Library extends a warm welcome to new and returning members of the Rivier University community for the 2026-2027 academic year. We hope you visit us often!



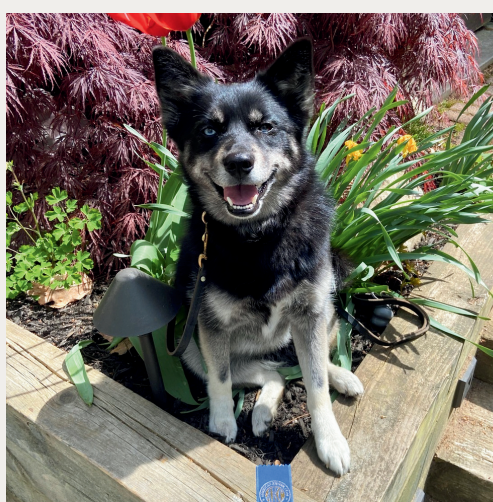
Therapy Dog Visits

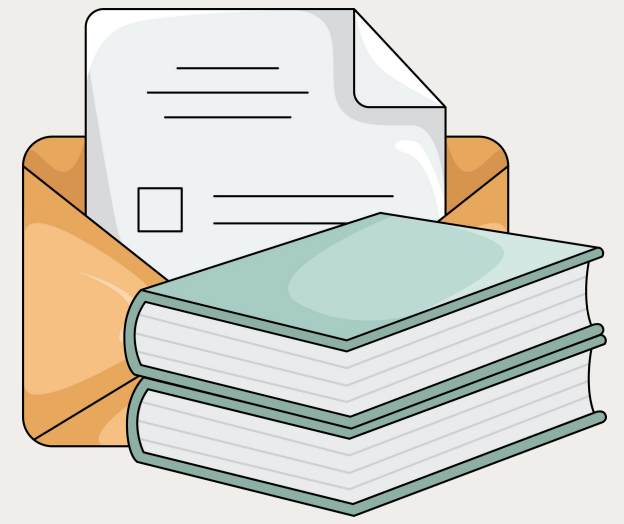




Did You Know?

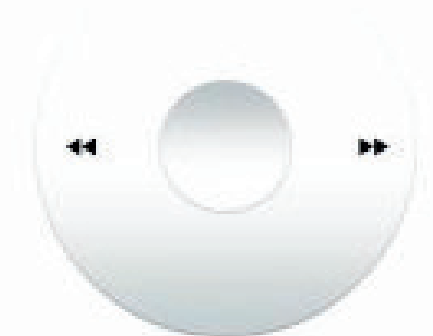
Staff Pick of the Month

The First 50 Years delivers a fast moving history that places Steve Jobs squarely at the center of Apple's rise, showing how his intensity and uncompromising standards shaped everything from product design to company culture.
