



## IMMUNIZATION POLICY

**The following Immunizations must be documented and presented to Rivier Health Services prior to August 15 (fall enrollment) and January 15 (spring enrollment) by all resident and all full and part time commuter students.**

- 2 doses of Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) or a positive MMR titer; an equivocal titer is considered negative
- Tdap within the last 10 years
- 3 doses of Hepatitis B or a positive Hepatitis B titer
- Meningitis ACWY (Menactra or Menveo at age 16 or later)
- Proof of 2 doses of Varicella Vaccine or a Varicella titer
- Titers must show positive immunization, equivocal is not accepted.
- Negative TB skin test within the last year prior to the first day of classes when required.
- **Proof of Fully Vaccinated status for Covid-19 -- by August 1, 2021**

### **Highly Recommended Vaccine**

Meningitis B at age 16 or within 2 years of residency (If 23 years of age or younger)

**Rivier University will consider a request for exemption only for the following:**

- **Medical Necessity/Contraindication**

You must submit Rivier University's Required Immunizations Waiver Form signed by your medical provider and notarized. If the student is over 18 the waiver must be signed by the student; if under 18 by the parent/guardian.

- **Religious Objection**

You must submit a notarized copy of Rivier University's Required Immunizations Waiver Form. If the student is over 18 the waiver must be signed by the student; if under 18 by the parent/guardian.

### **Quarantine Policy**

In the case of an outbreak on campus for which students are not immunized as required by the University, the student will be required to leave campus until the New Hampshire Department of Health determines it is safe for the student to return. If the student is quarantined from campus, the student is not eligible for tuition, room, or board refunds and may suffer academic consequences if class or lab attendance is necessary to meet course requirements.
