APPROACH

A Confidential Resource Advisor offers free, confidential, non-judgmental, restorative, and traumainformed support services. Rather than directing your decisions, the advisor provides information and resources to help you explore the best next steps for yourself and your peers.



SERVICES

- > Provide information, including:
 - Reporting options and the effects of each option
 - · Counseling services available on campus and through a local rape crisis or domestic violence center
 - Medical and health services available on and off campus
 - Campus escort services for security
 - Academic and residence life accommodations
 - The investigative and disciplinary process at Rivier
 - The legal process carried out through local, state and federal government agencies
 - Students' rights and the institution's responsibilities regarding a protection order, no contact order, and any other lawful orders issued by the institution or by a criminal, civil or tribal court
- > Assist the reporting party in contacting or reporting to campus or local law enforcement agencies (if directed by the reporting party).
- > May attend an administrative or institution-based adjudication proceeding as the advisor or support person of the student's or employee's choice.
