

What to bring with you to Rivier University

Making your room your home-away-from-home



Welcome to the Rivier University residential community! We are excited that you will be joining us this year! Packing for university life can be an exciting, but sometimes overwhelming task. Use the list below as a guide to what to bring and what to leave at home.

What to Bring

**These are simply suggestions
not requirements**

- ☐ Pillows, towels, blankets, & (twin extra-long) bedding
- ☐ Egg crate and/or mattress pad
- ☐ Laundry bag, detergent, etc. Remember: laundry is free!
- ☐ Toiletries, shower caddy and shower shoes
- ☐ Small trash can
- ☐ Plates, bowls, cups, & utensils (paper or plastic)
- ☐ Fan
- ☐ Area rug (we suggest 5x7) or smaller
- ☐ Power Strip with surge protector (must be UL approved)
- ☐ Posting putty or painters tape (no tape or nails permitted)
- ☐ Under the bed storage bins
- ☐ If you live close by, bring seasonal clothes only
- ☐ Laptop/Printer (or use university computer/print labs; wireless printers not recommended)
- ☐ Desk/school supplies – writing implements, paper, stapler, etc
- ☐ Talk to roommate(s) about large items such as TVs, streaming devices, gaming systems, etc.

What NOT to Bring

- ☐ Appliances with open heating elements (i.e. electric coffee makers, hot plates, grills, etc.) are against city fire laws and therefore strictly prohibited
- ☐ Personal microwaves - remember: a Microfridge (microwave/fridge unit) is provided to you
- ☐ Individual heating units/hot air blowers, air conditioning units and halogen lamps, are not allowed.
- ☐ Candles/Incense/wax warmers - Open flame sources such as candles, potpourri burners, incense, bottled gas appliances, lanterns and the like are prohibited in residence hall rooms
- ☐ Flags/Banners/Tapestries larger than 3'x5' are prohibited per the Nashua Fire Marshal
- ☐ Cinder Blocks/Bed Risers – all beds are adjustable
- ☐ Personal beds, desks, chairs – all furniture is provided by Rivier and cannot be removed
- ☐ Pets should remain at home - Fish and fish bowls are permitted – no tanks, filters or lights
