August 1, 2026

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Executive Summary

Rivier University conducted its biennial Campus Climate Survey during the 2025–26 academic year, in accordance with RSA 188-H:4. The survey was distributed to 2,366 students. A total of 374 students (15.81%) participated in the survey. Response counts vary by question due to survey skip logic and voluntary participation. Results reflect the perceptions and experiences of students who chose to participate.

Survey results show that students feel satisfied, safe, and confident in how the University responds to concerns. At the same time, the results highlight ways we can improve reporting, increase awareness of resources, and better support students who do not formally report incidents.

Key Findings

- Strong Satisfaction
 - 76% would recommend Rivier
 - 71% would choose Rivier again
- High Sense of Safety
 - 87% of students feel safe on campus
- Strong Trust
 - 85%+ believe the University responds appropriately to reports
- Awareness Gap
 - 30–40% of students unsure how the reporting process works
- Reporting Behavior Gap
 - Many students did not formally report incidents, even though they expressed confidence in university response systems.

About the Survey - Overview and Administration Details

Under New Hampshire RSA 188-H:4 requirements, institutions of higher education must administer a campus climate survey biennially. Rivier University conducted its Campus Climate Survey during the 2025–2026 academic year, utilizing the state-provided “base survey” developed by a statewide task force. The University did not append additional institution-specific questions.

The survey instrument included 10 modules totaling 246 questions, assessing campus climate, student experiences, awareness of resources, and institutional response.

Administration Timeline

- February 13-March 6, 2026

Population

- The survey was distributed to degree-seeking students enrolled during the Spring 2026 semester.

Distribution and Outreach

- The survey invitation was distributed electronically to students' Rivier University email accounts, with two reminder emails sent during the survey window.
- Outreach efforts included faculty and staff encouraging student participation, with athletics staff providing targeted reminders to teams.
- Flyers with QR codes were posted throughout residence halls and campus buildings, and a tabling event was held in the Dion Center lobby to promote the survey.
- To encourage participation, 25 prizes were offered as incentives for students who completed the survey.

Response Rates & Insights

- Survey invitations sent: 2,366
- Total survey participants: 374
- Participation rate: 15.81%
- Response counts vary across individual questions due to skip logic and voluntary participation.
- Not all respondents answered every question
- Results reflect self-reported student perceptions and experience

Survey Limitations

- Findings reflect the experiences and perceptions of students who chose to participate and may not represent the views of all students.
- Response counts varied across question groups due to skip logic and voluntary participation.
- Some follow-up questions had small response counts and should be interpreted cautiously.

Student Awareness and Engagement

- Approximately 67% of students report receiving education about sexual misconduct prior to enrolling at Rivier.
- Since enrolling, students report engagement through:
 - Conversations with peers
 - Campus programs and prevention efforts
 - Awareness campaigns, including posters and communications

- Many students also report receiving information on:
 - How to report incidents
 - Where to go for help
 - Institutional policies and protections

Section I: Campus Climate & Perceptions

Campus Satisfaction & Belonging

- 76% would recommend Rivier
- 71% would attend again
- 68% agree or strongly agree that they are satisfied with life

Interpretation: Students demonstrate strong connection to their Rivier experience and overall institutional satisfaction.

Student Well-Being

- 73% feel happy most/all of the time
- 48% feel calm and peaceful most or all of the time
- 31% experience periods of emotional distress

Interpretation: While overall trends are positive, a subset of students continues to experience emotional strain.

Safety Perceptions

- 87% feel safe on campus

Interpretation: Safety remains a core institutional strength.

Institutional Trust

- 85%+ believe Rivier will:
 - Take reports seriously
 - Maintain confidentiality
 - Offer support

Interpretation: Trust in institutional response systems is consistently high.

Awareness of Policies & Resources

- 70% know where to get help
- 63% know how to report
- 59% understand reporting processes

Interpretation: While most students report awareness of reporting and support resources, gaps remain in students' understanding of reporting processes.

Resource Awareness

- High awareness: Campus Security, Counseling
- Lower awareness: CARES

Interpretation: Key student support resources are not equally visible to all students. Increasing awareness of CARES and other supportive resources presents an opportunity to strengthen early intervention and help-seeking behaviors.

Section II: Student Experiences

Overview of Experiences

- 92–98% report no direct experience across most behaviors
- A small subset reports harassment and other misconduct

Interpretation: While prevalence is relatively low, experiences are still impactful for affected students.

Context of Incidents

- Primarily on campus
- Within the academic term
- Involving other students

Impact on Students

- Academic impacts (GPA, course changes)
- Financial impacts (housing, services)

Interpretation: Even isolated incidents can significantly affect student success.

Section III: Reporting & Help-Seeking

Reporting Behavior

- Majority do not formally report
- Smaller portion engage formal systems

Informal Disclosure

Students are more likely to tell peers or friends and less likely to use formal institutional processes.

Barriers to Reporting

- Privacy concerns
- Perception of seriousness
- Shame or discomfort
- Uncertainty about outcomes

Interpretation: Reporting barriers show a combination of emotional, cultural, and informational factors, rather than a lack of trust in institutional response or processes.

Section IV: Institutional Response

Perceived Response

Students expect:

- Fairness
- Confidentiality
- Support

Experienced Response

- Among the small number of respondents who interacted with institutional support systems and answered follow-up questions, most reported positive experiences and indicated they received support, accommodations, or resources.

Key Disconnect: Students trust the system but often choose not to engage in it.

Section V: Key Insights & Themes

1. Strong Campus Foundation - High safety, satisfaction, and trust
2. Awareness-to-Action Gap - Knowledge does not consistently lead to reporting behavior
3. Reporting Hesitation - Driven by perception and experience versus lack of trust
4. Uneven Resource Visibility - Some support options remain underutilized

5. Ongoing Student Stress - A subset of students continues to experience emotional strain

Section VI: Priority Action Areas

1. Normalize Reporting

- Reinforce reporting as supported and expected
- Use peer influence and student voice

2. Clarify Reporting Processes

- Simplify communication about what happens after a report is filed

3. Increase Resource Visibility

- Emphasize CARES and case management resources

4. Strengthen Mental Health Supports

- Expand awareness and access to on and off campus services

5. Leverage Institutional Trust

- Highlight positive response experiences and available supports

Conclusion

The 2026 Campus Climate Survey affirms Rivier University as a campus with:

- Strong safety and satisfaction outcomes
- High levels of trust
- Effective systems of support with opportunities to increase awareness, engagement, and reporting

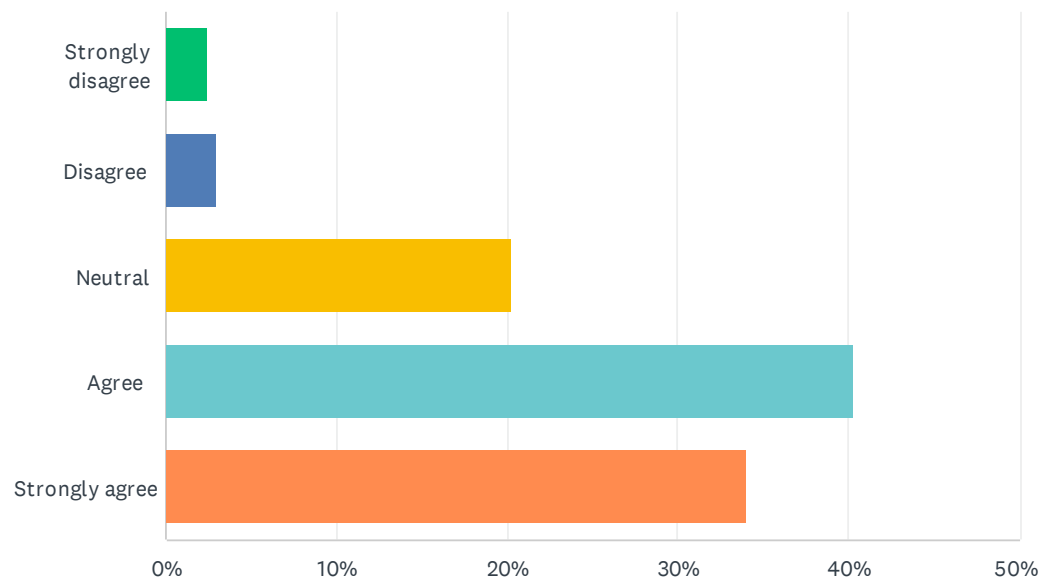
Rivier University will use these findings to guide prevention education, reporting awareness efforts, resource promotion, and student support initiatives over the next biennial survey cycle.

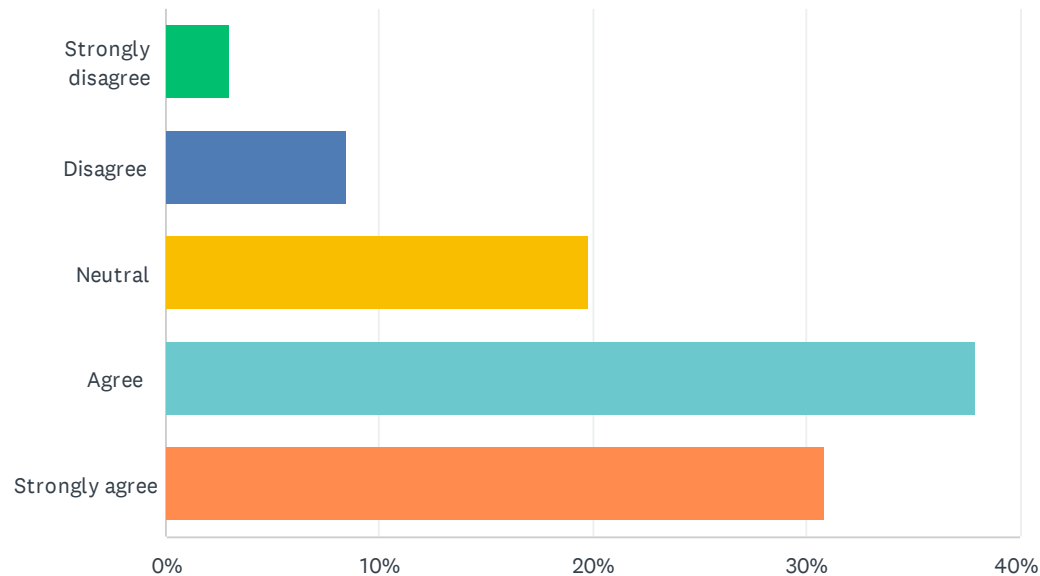

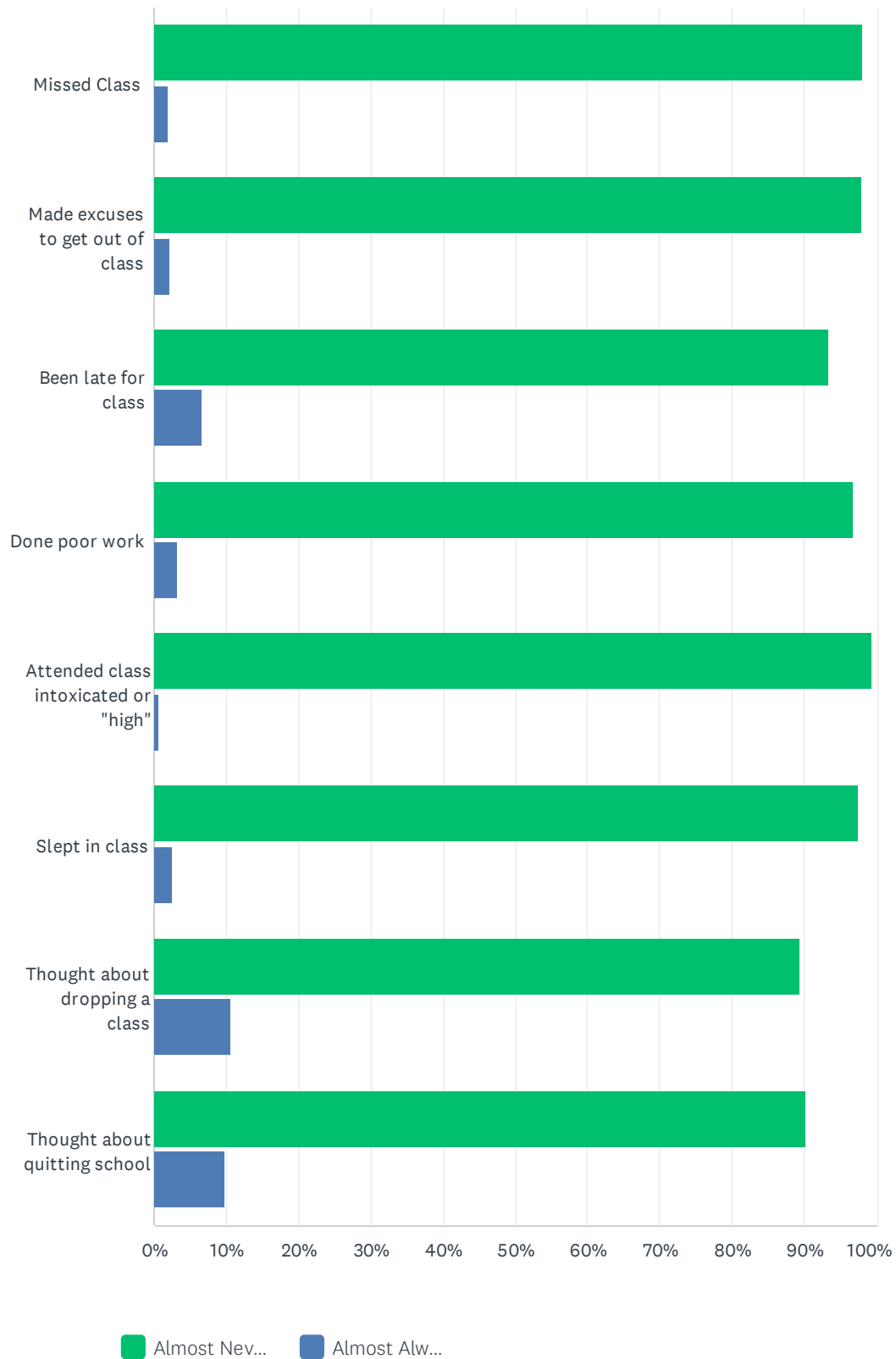

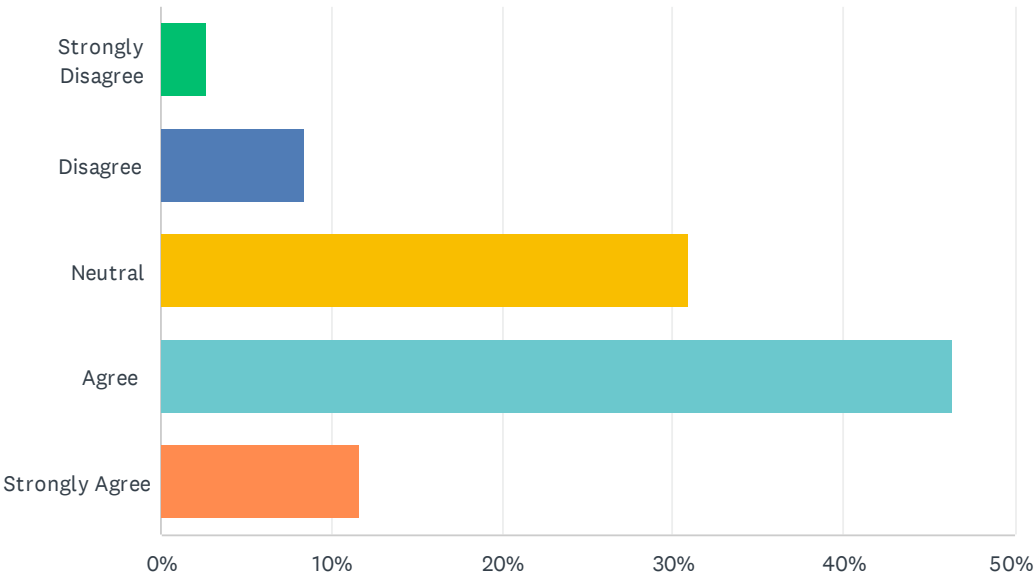

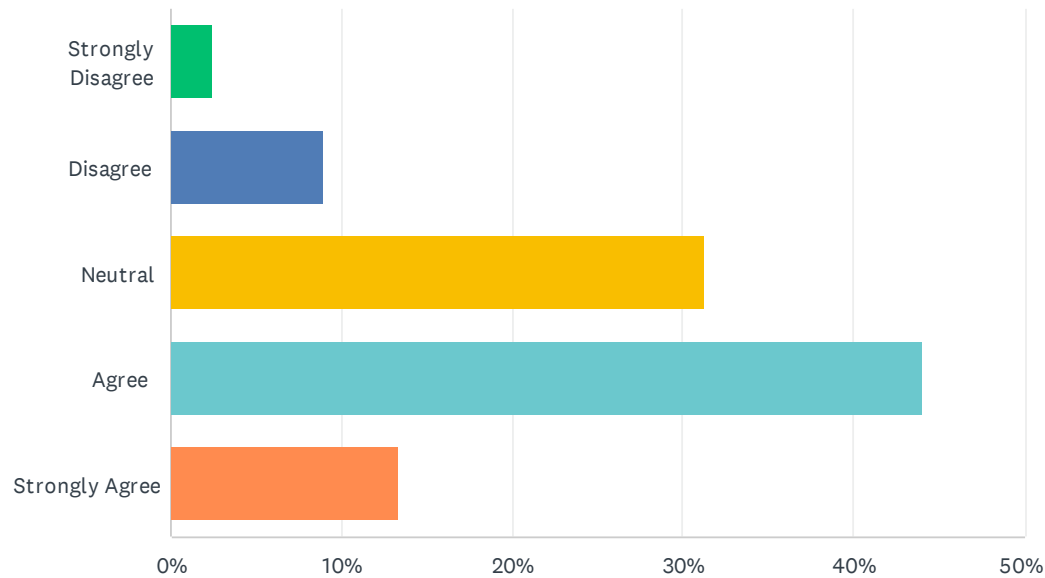

Q5 The conditions of my life are excellent.

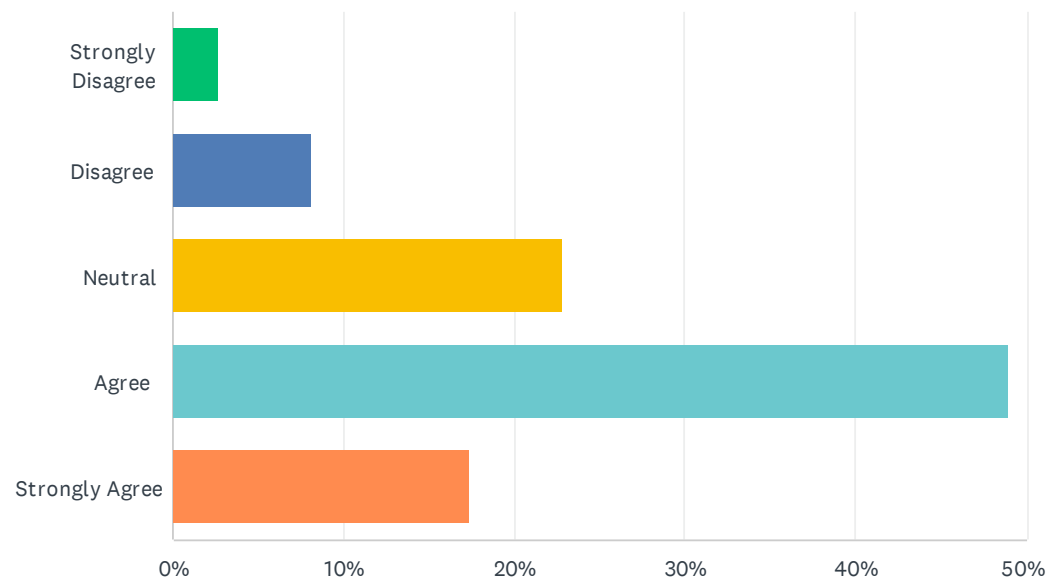

Q6 I am satisfied with life.

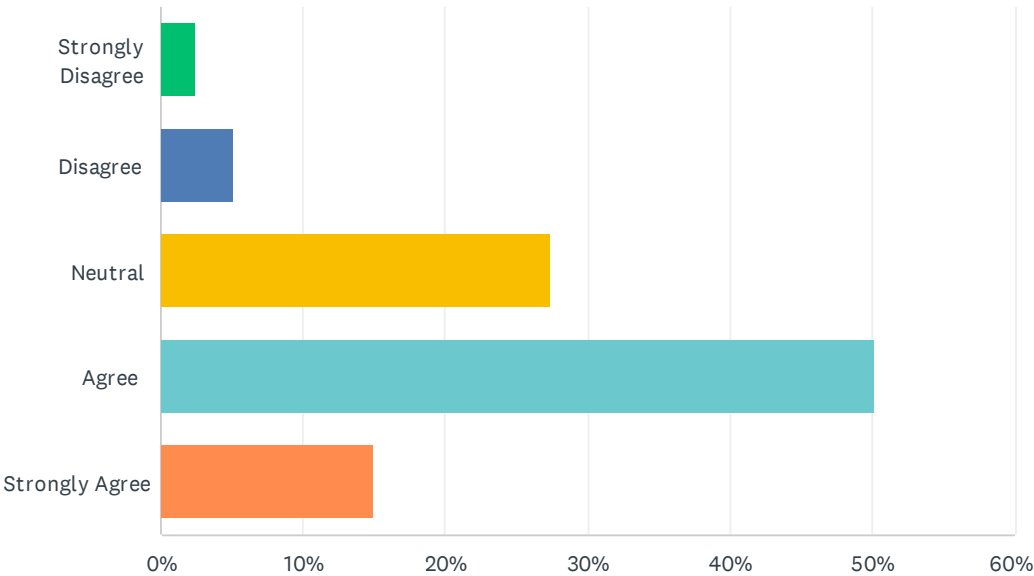

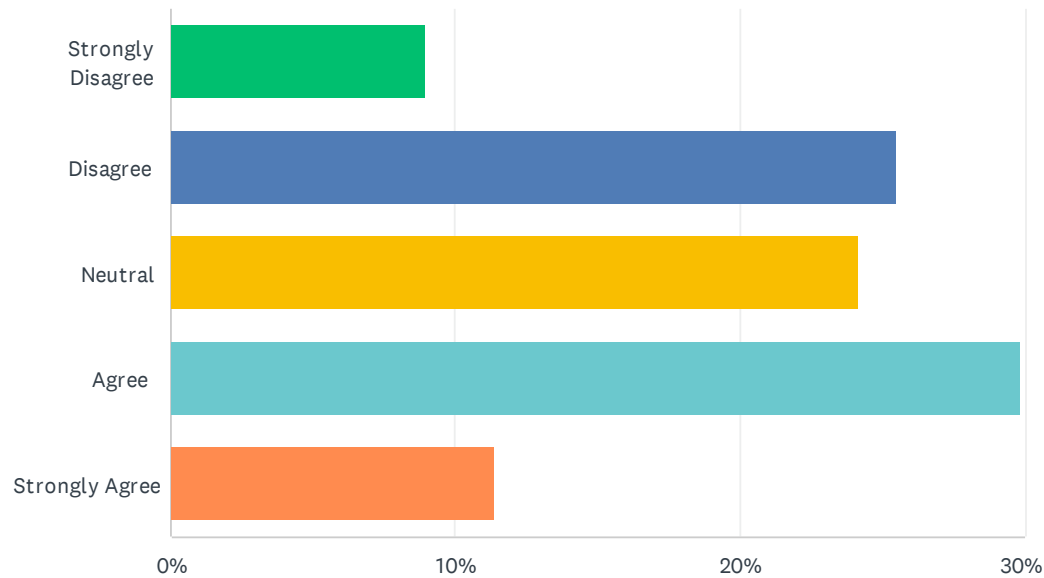

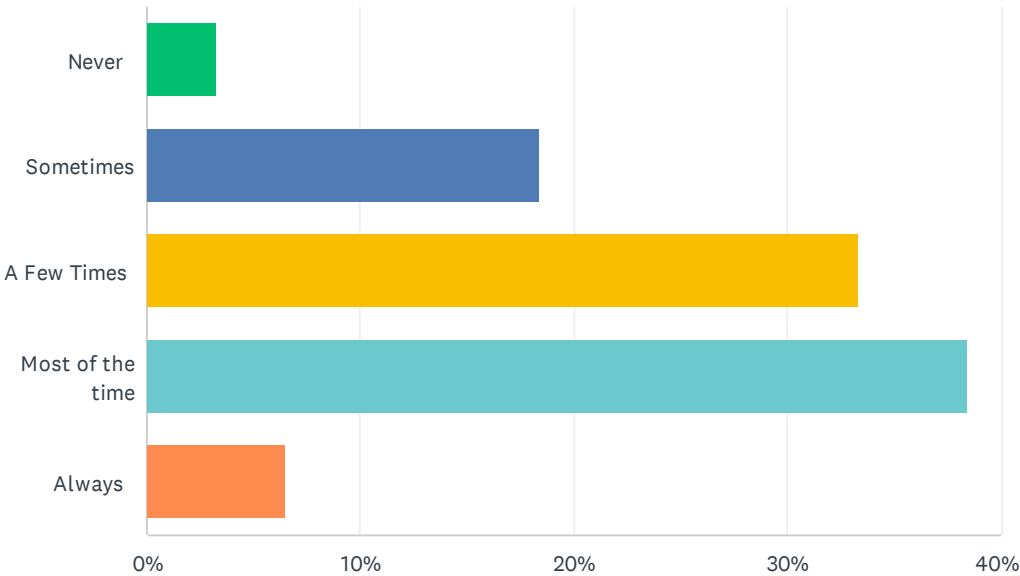

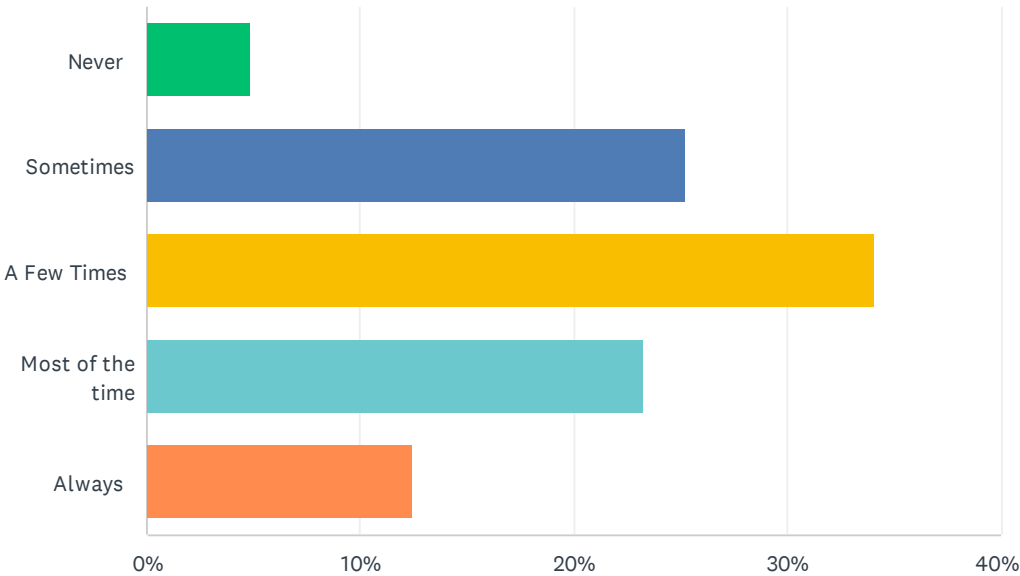

Q10 Been a very nervous person?

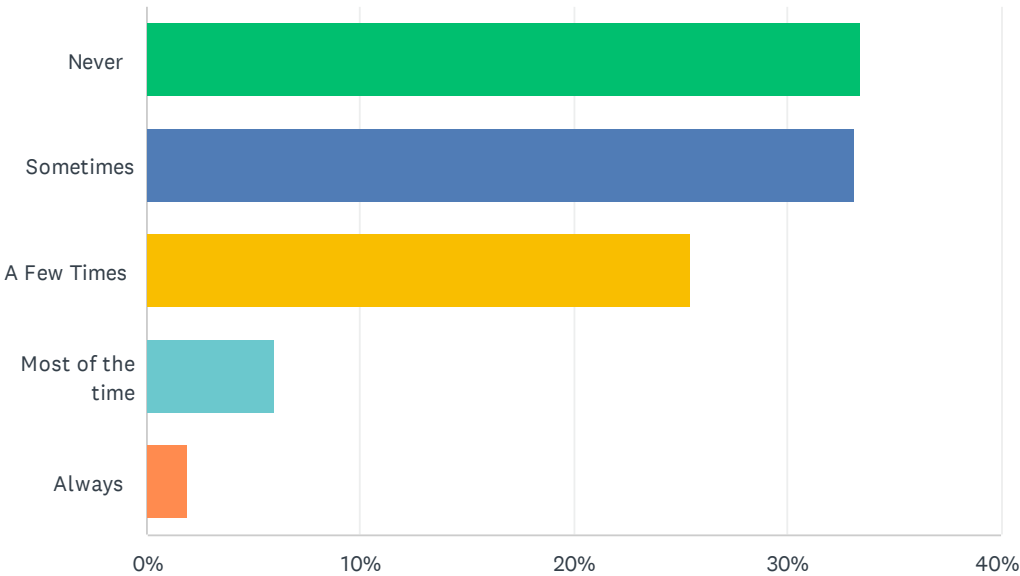

Q11 Felt so down in the dumps that nothing could cheer you up?

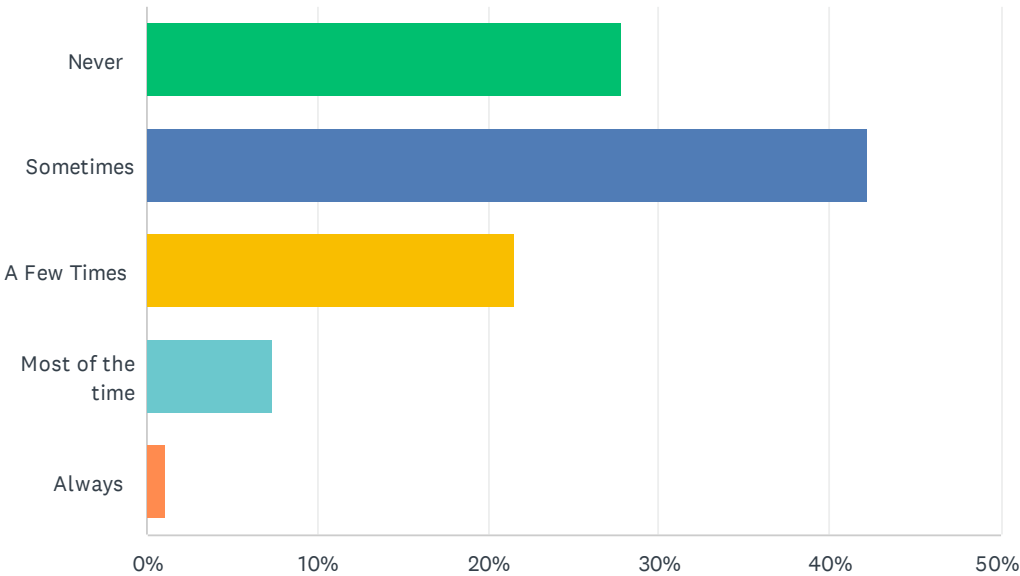

Q12 Felt down-hearted and blue?

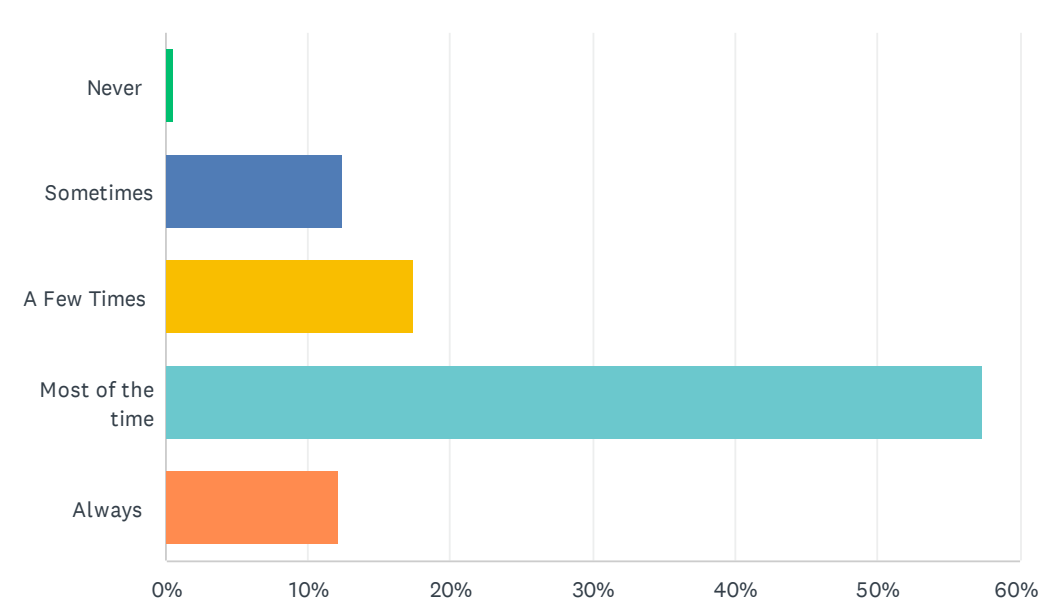

Q13 Been a happy person?

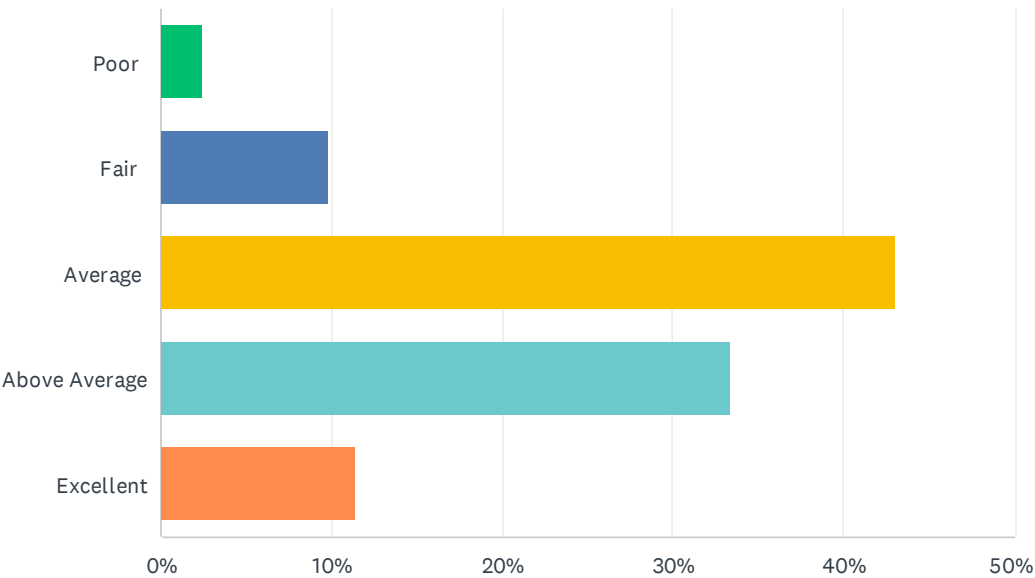

Q14 I would rate my health overall as:

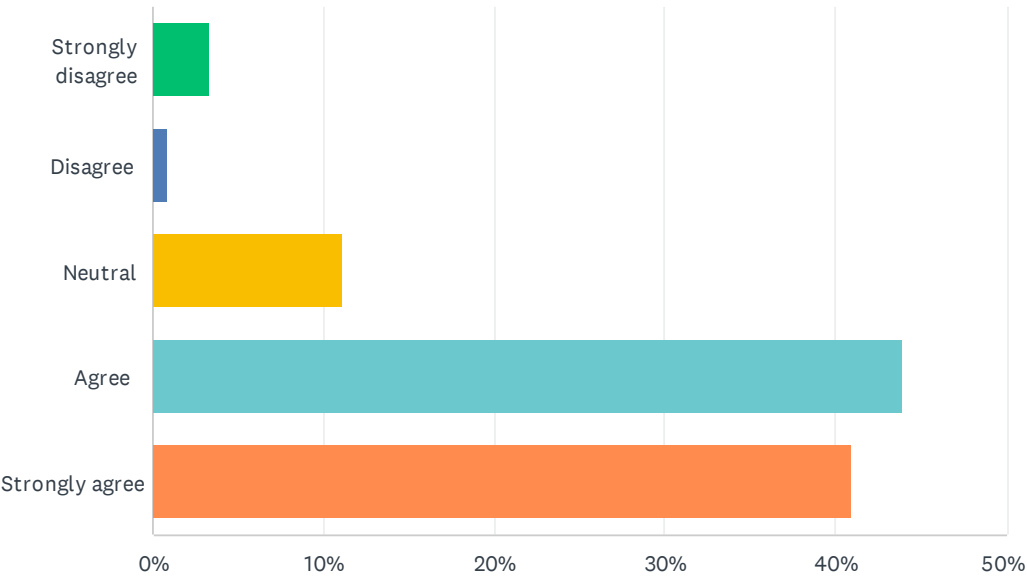

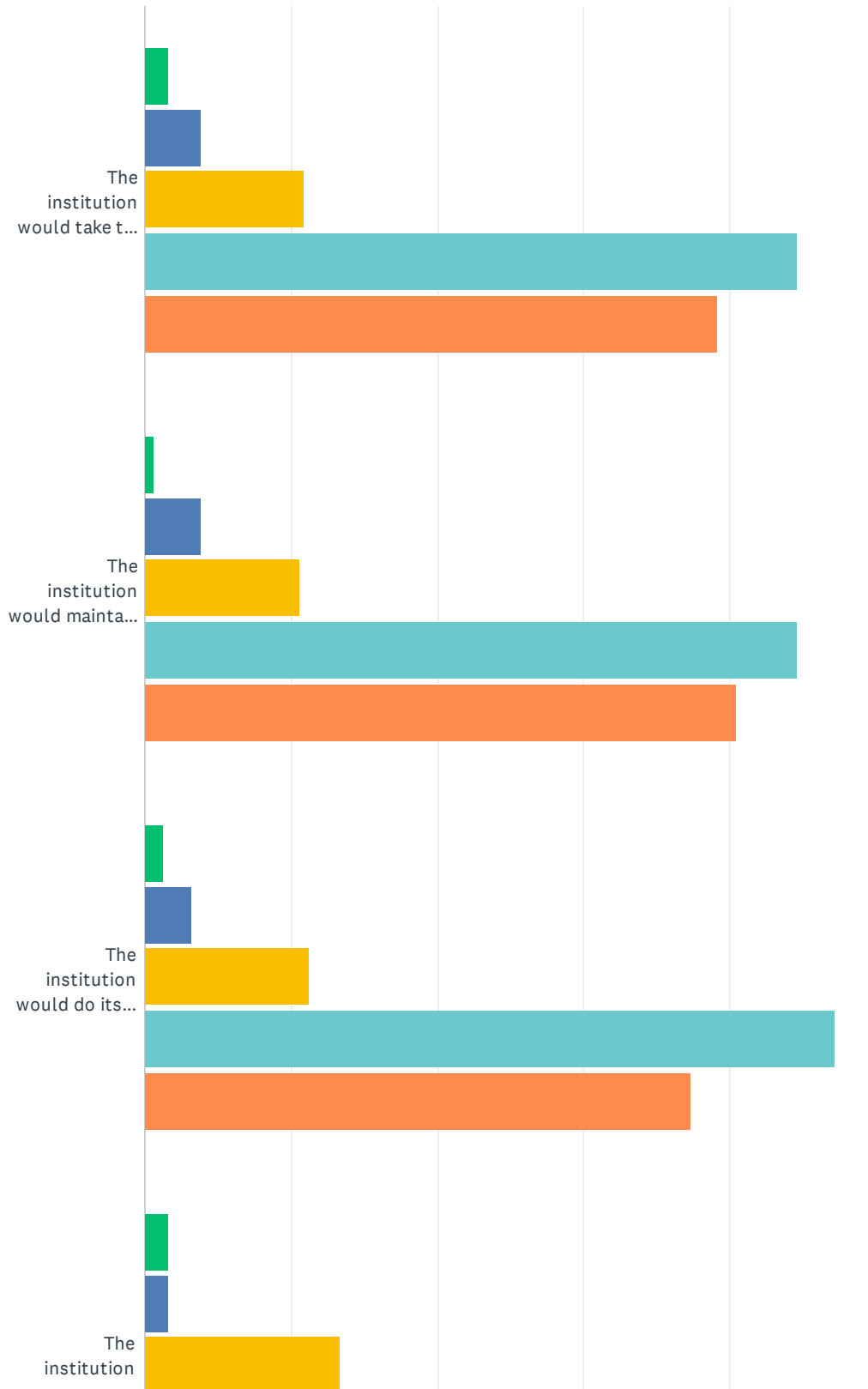

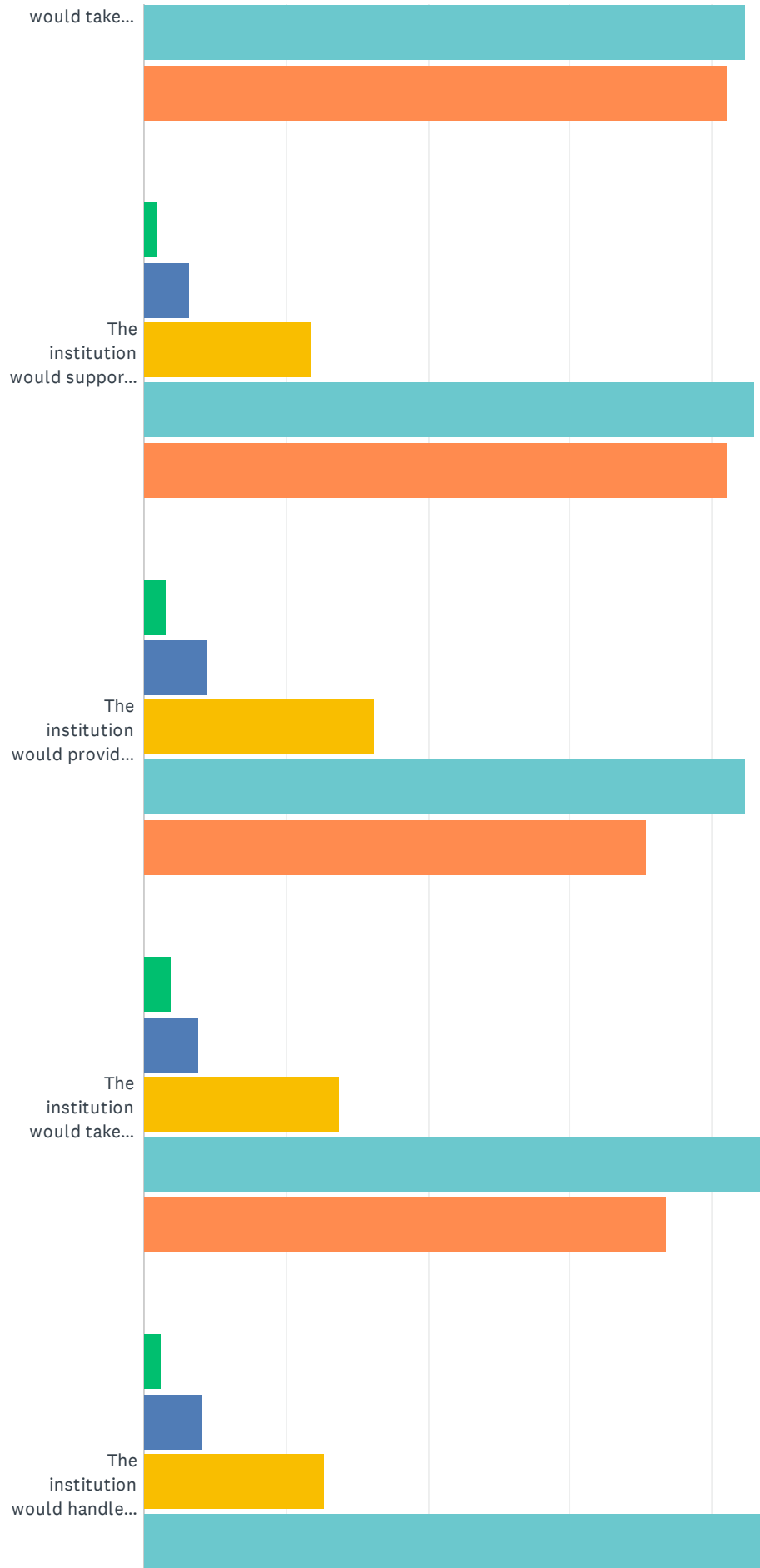

Q16 Using the scale provided, please indicate the likelihood of each statement

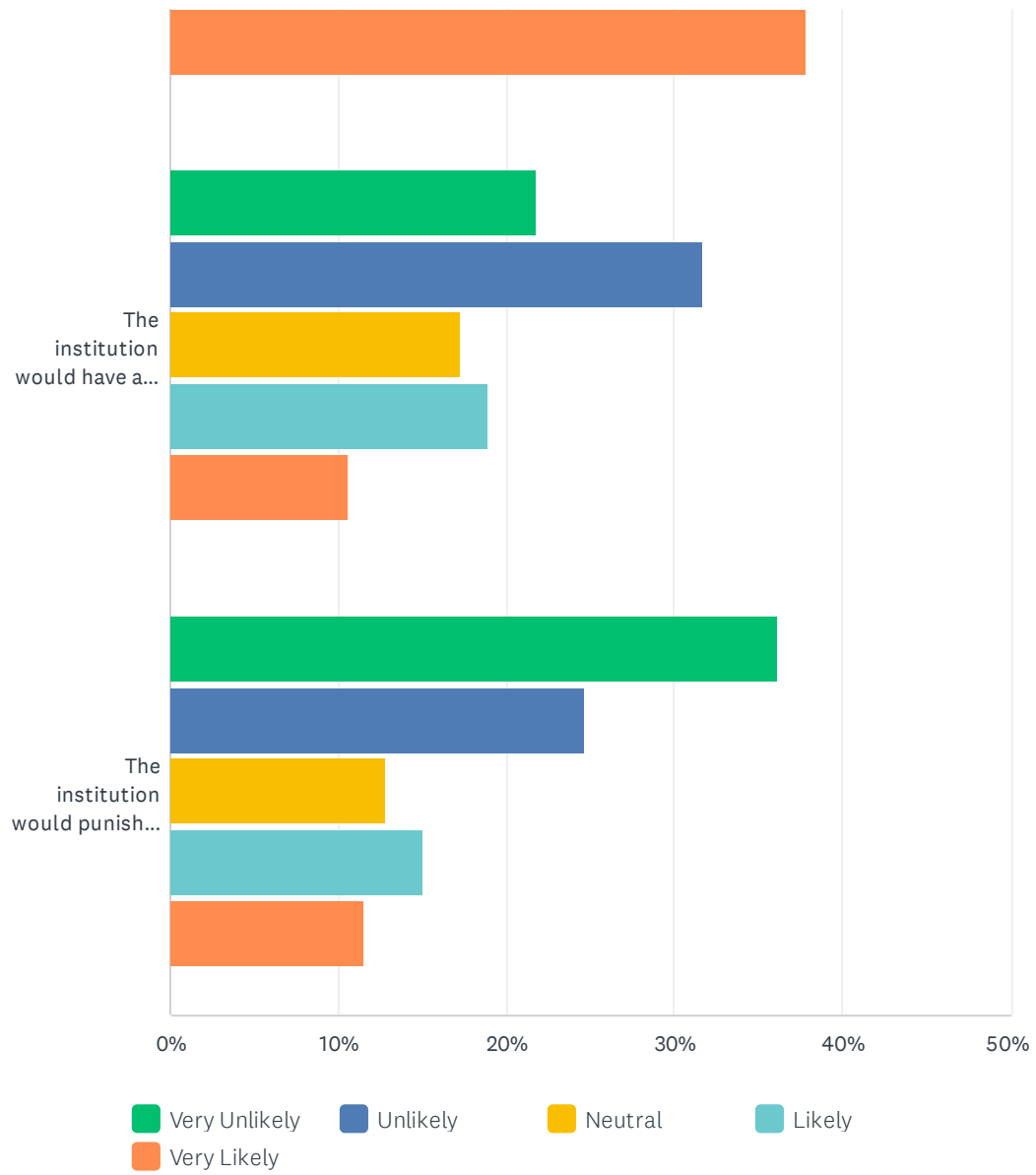

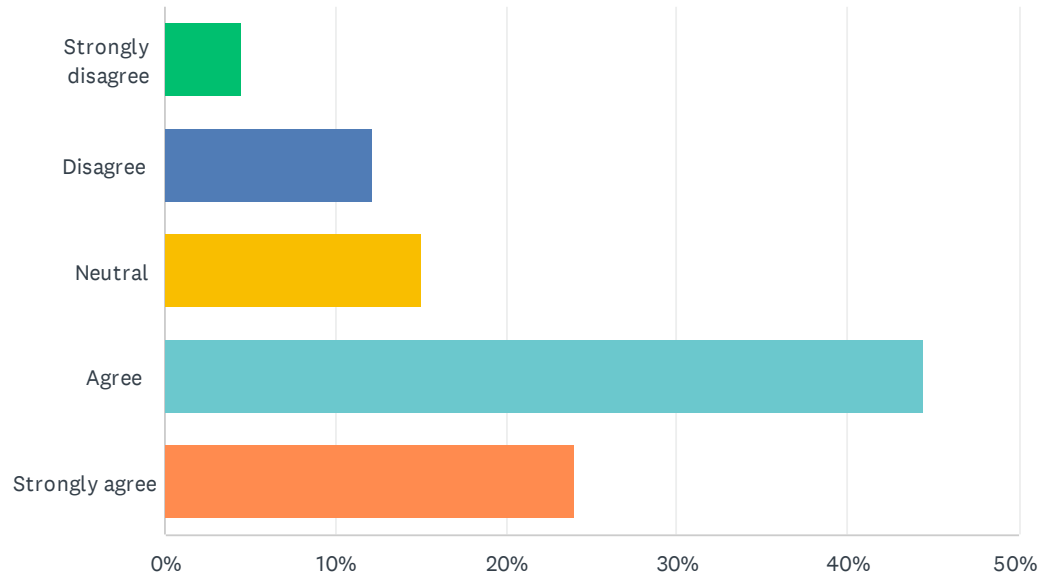

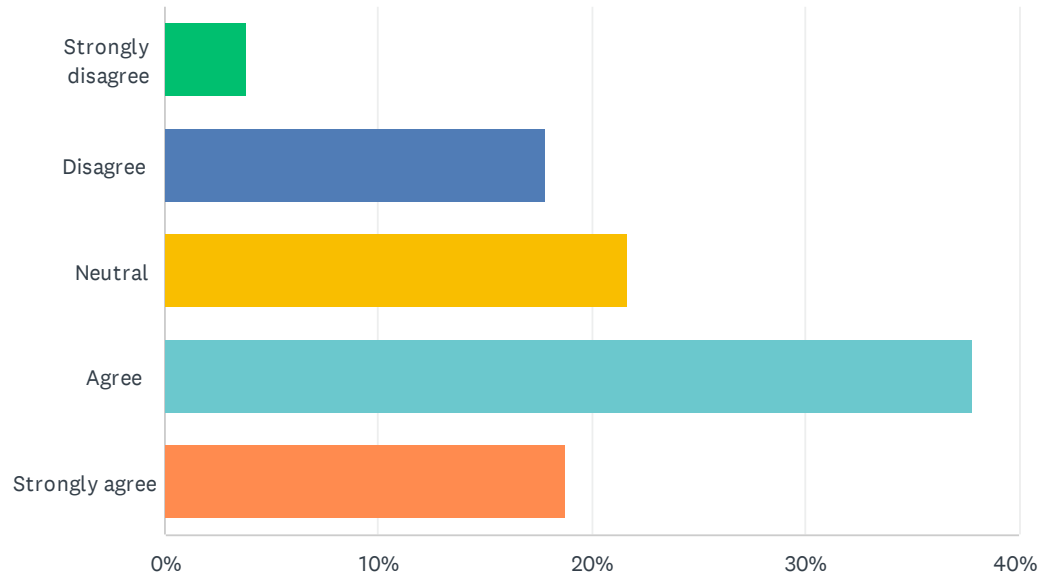

Q18 I understand what happens when a student reports a claim of sexual misconduct at Rivier University.

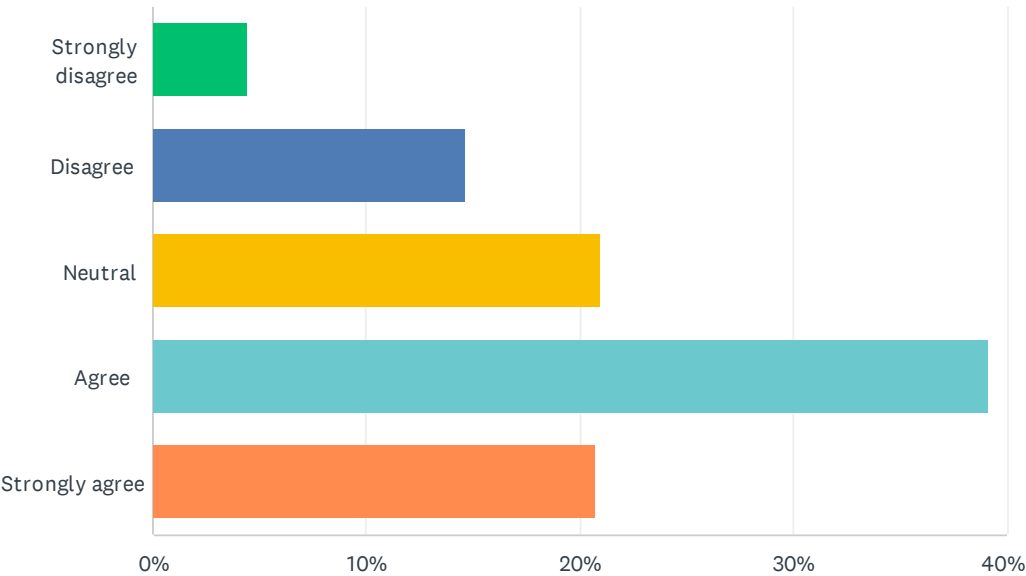

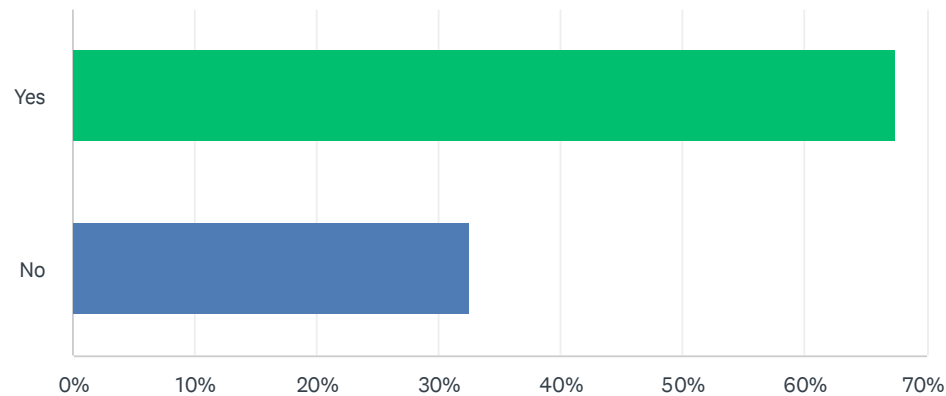

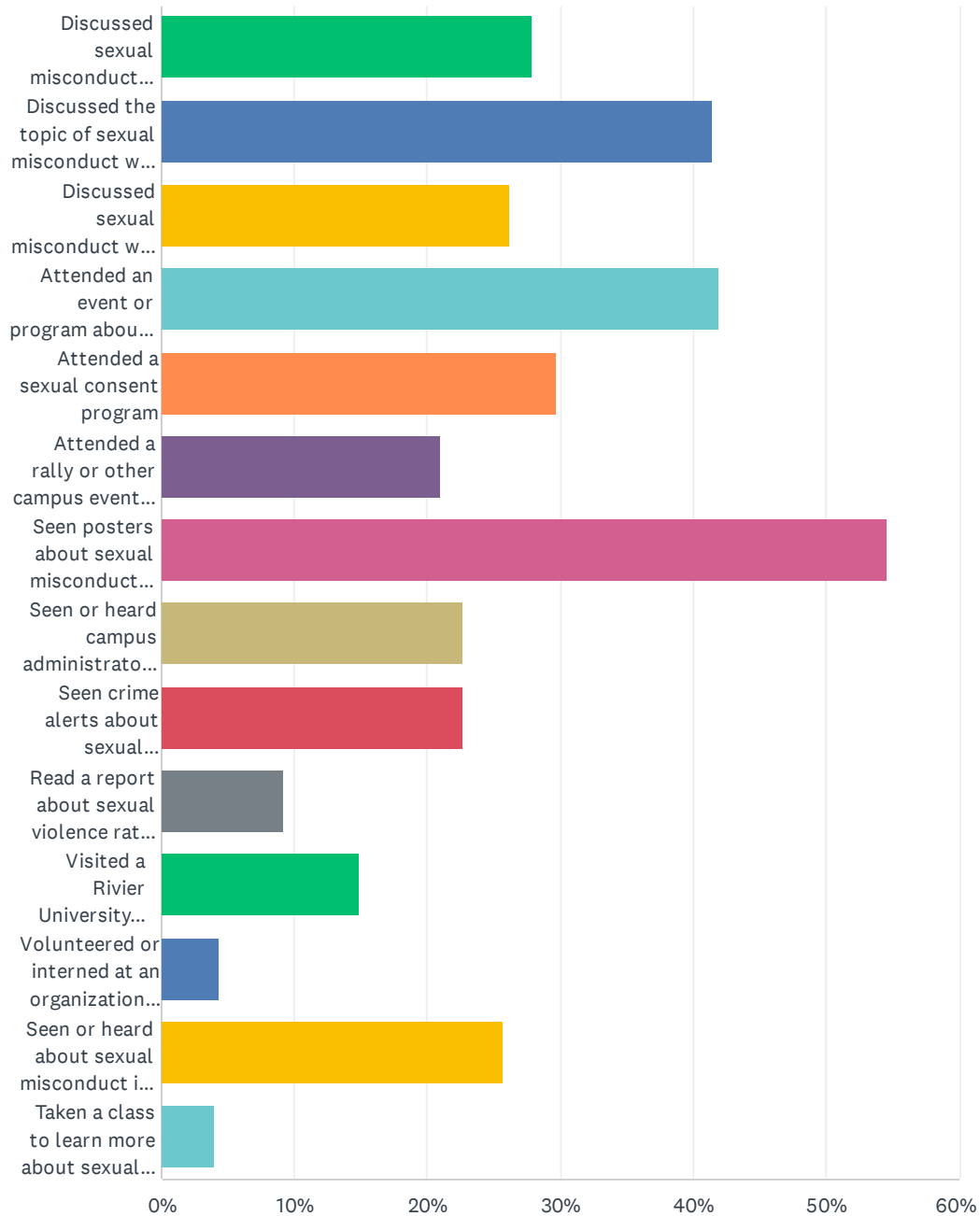

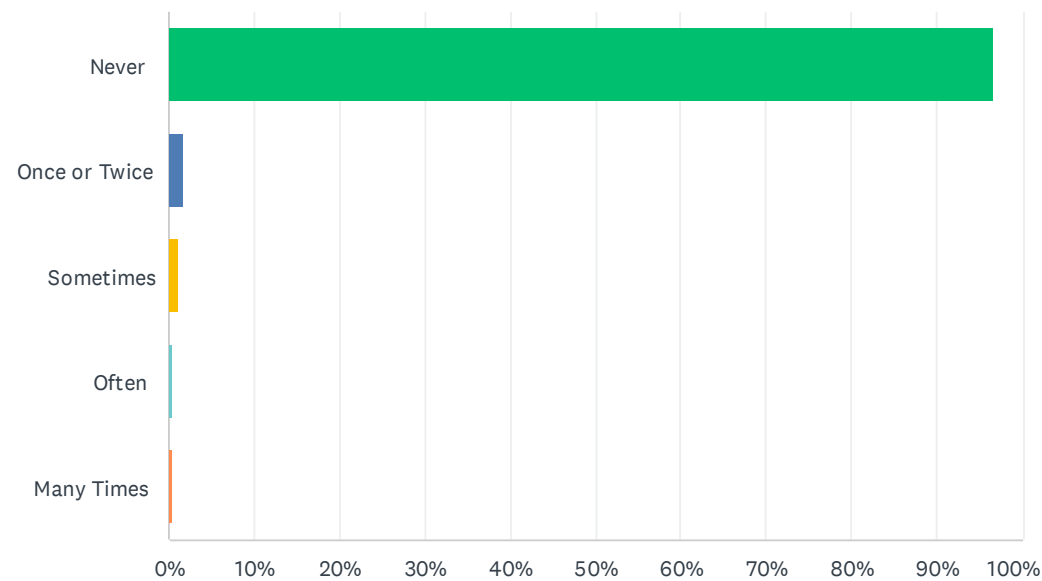

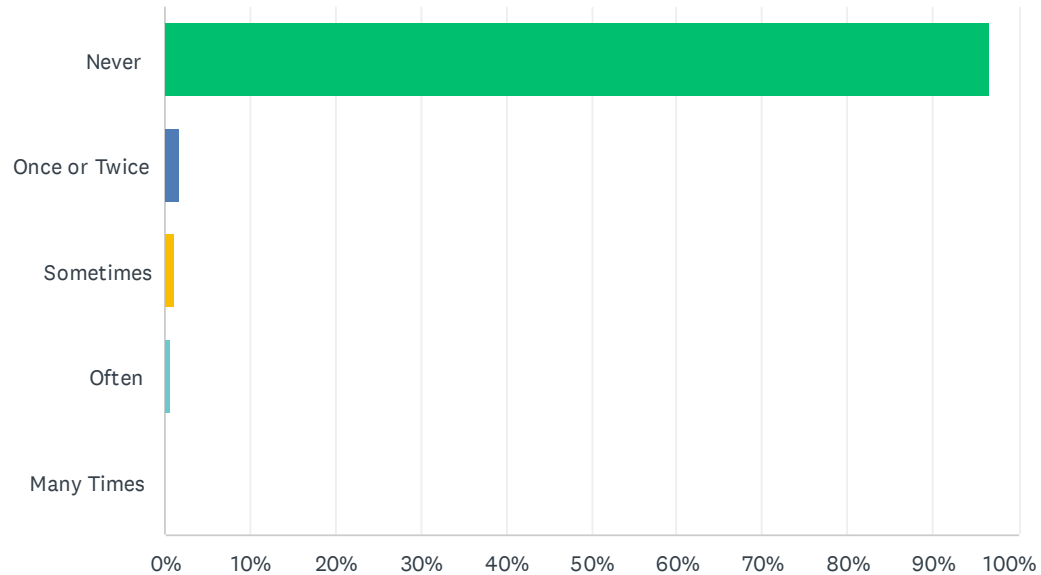

Q28 Put you down or was condescending to you because of your sex or gender identity?

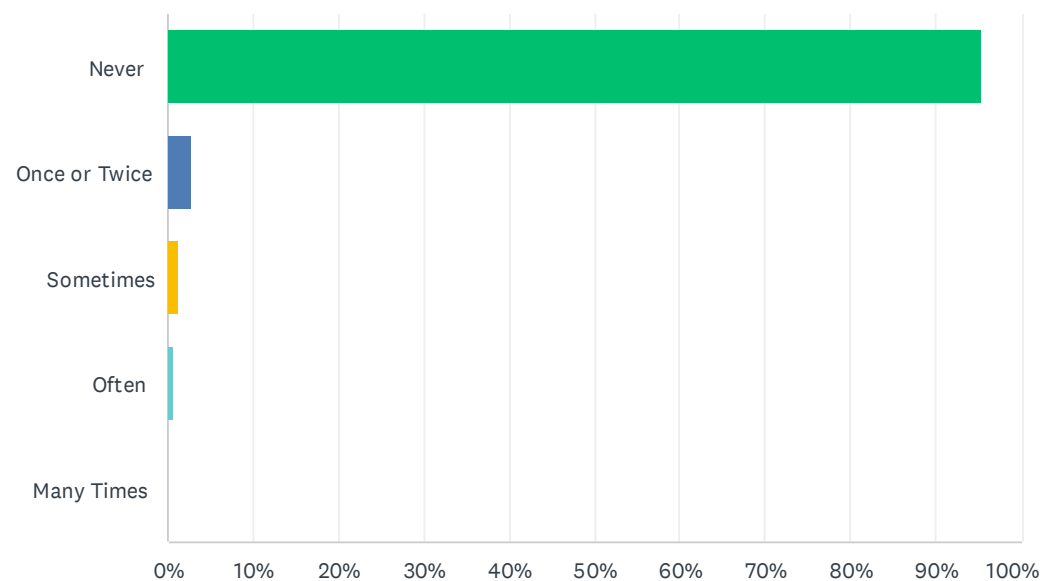

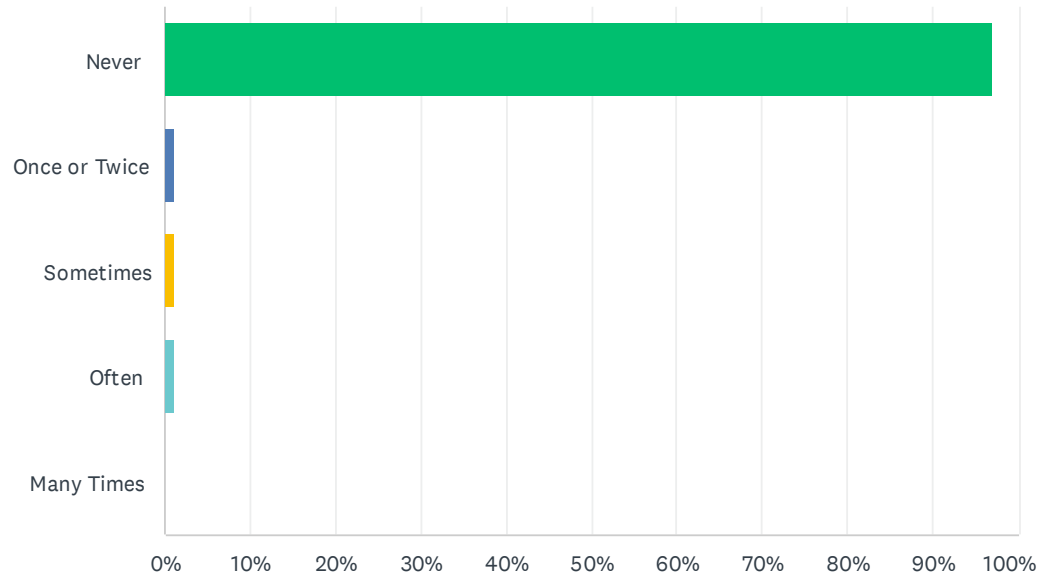

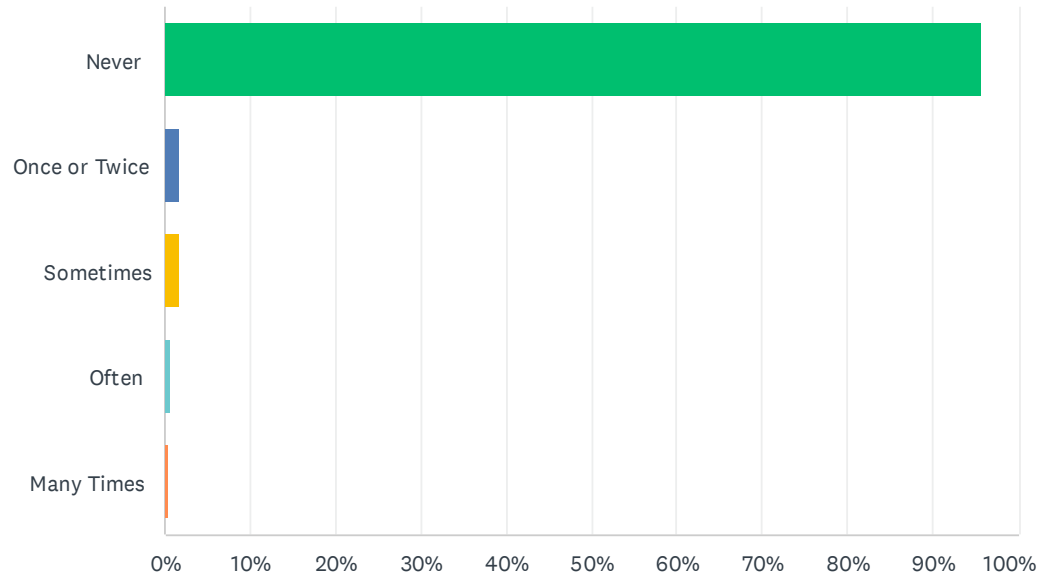

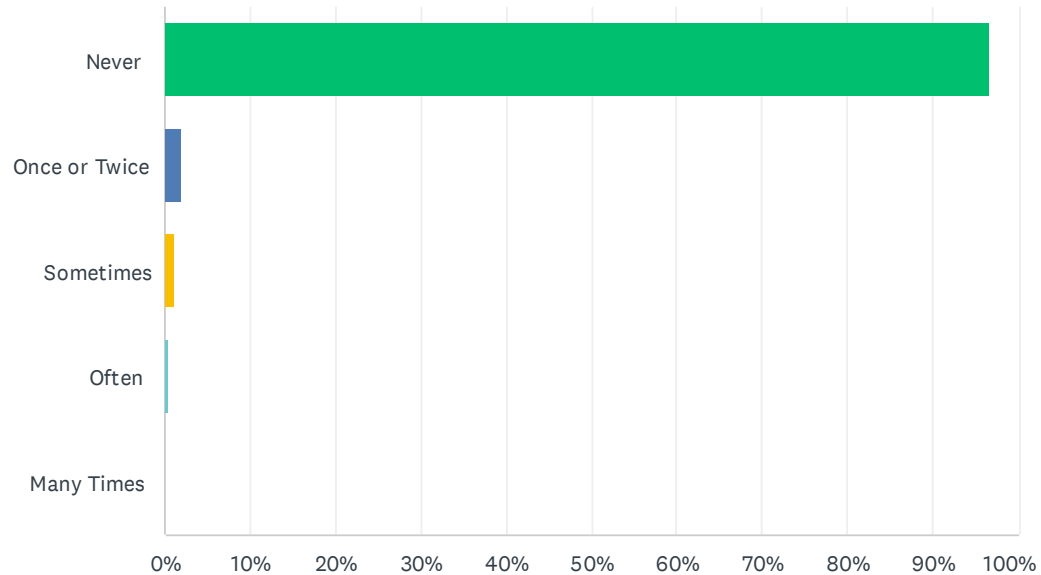

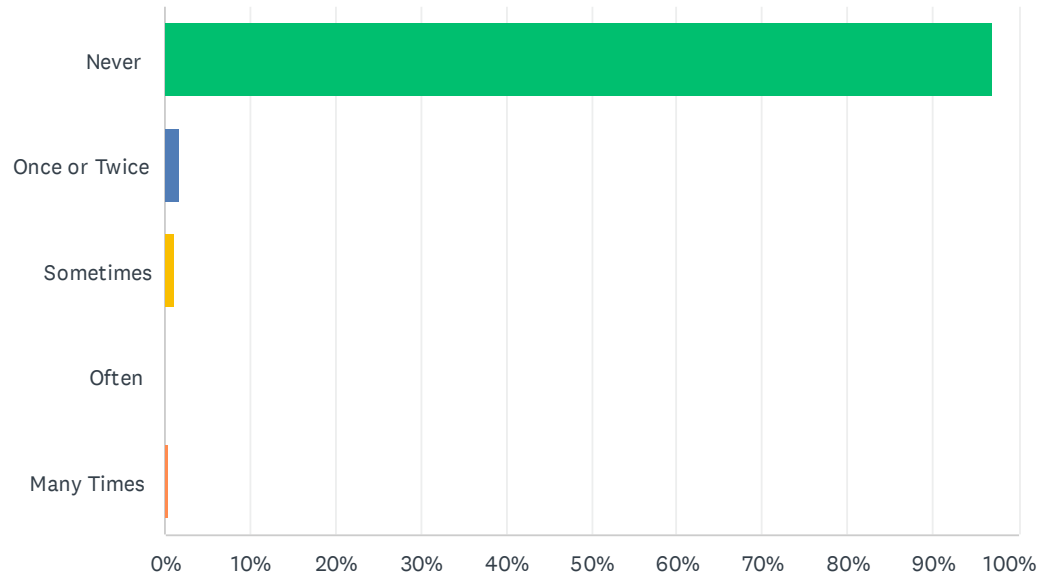

Q33 Made unwanted attempts to establish a romantic or sexual relationship with you, despite your efforts to discourage it?

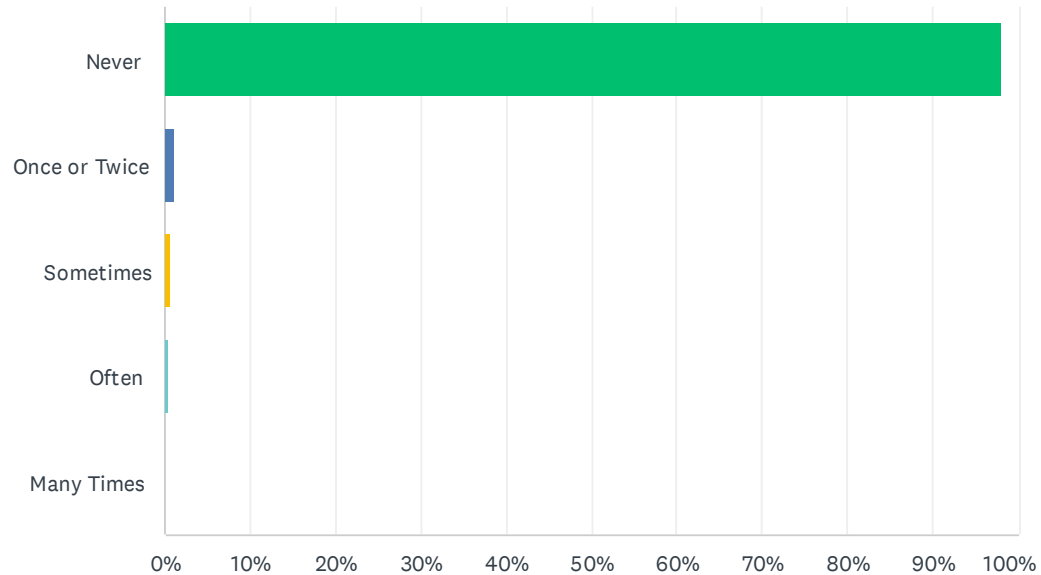

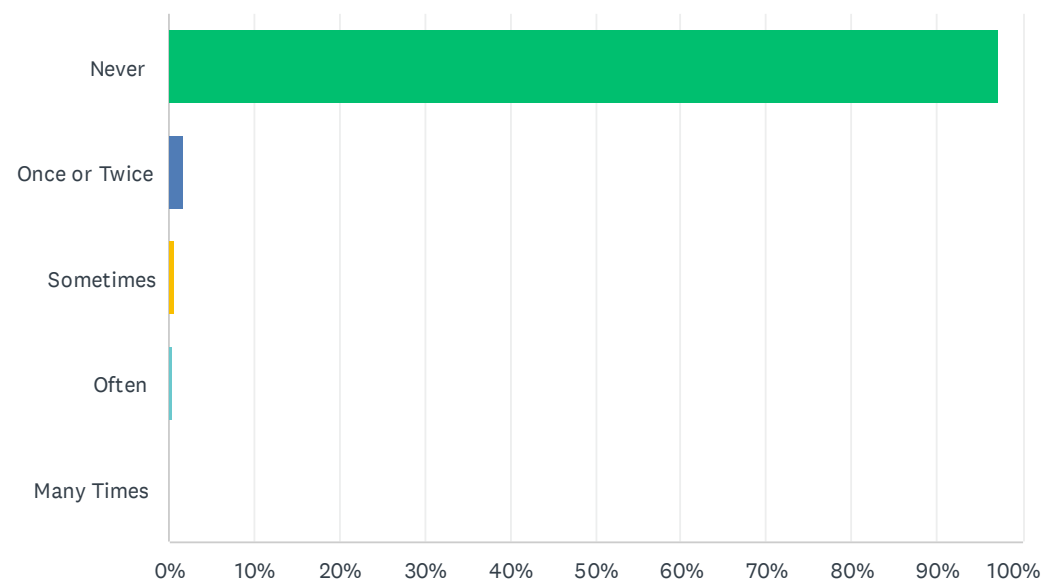

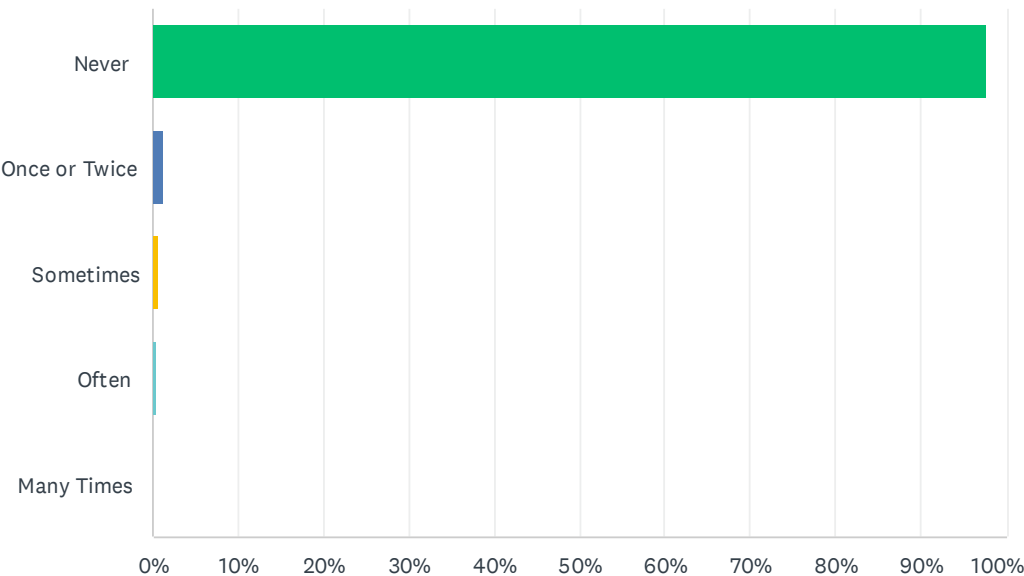

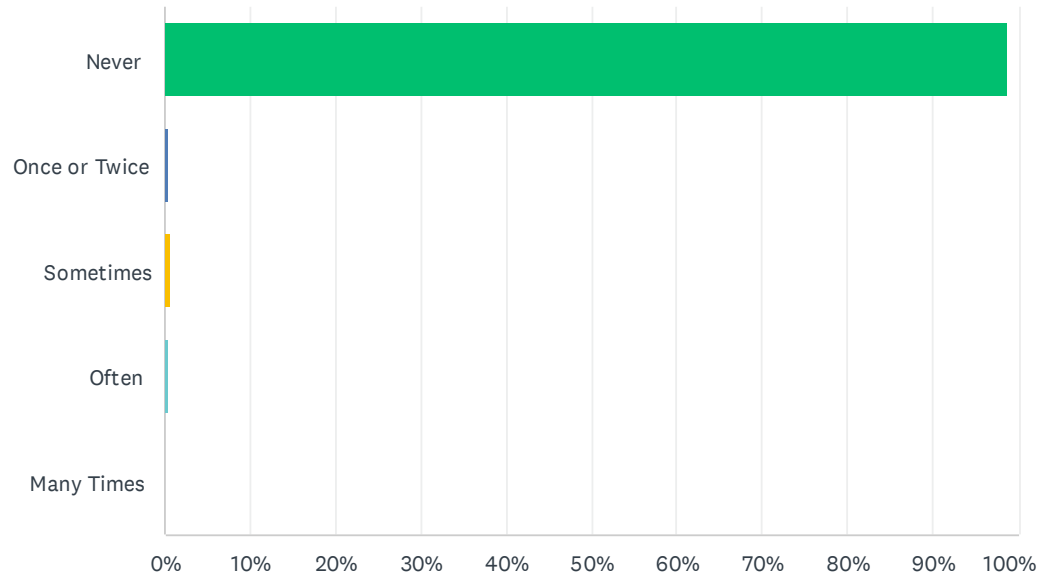

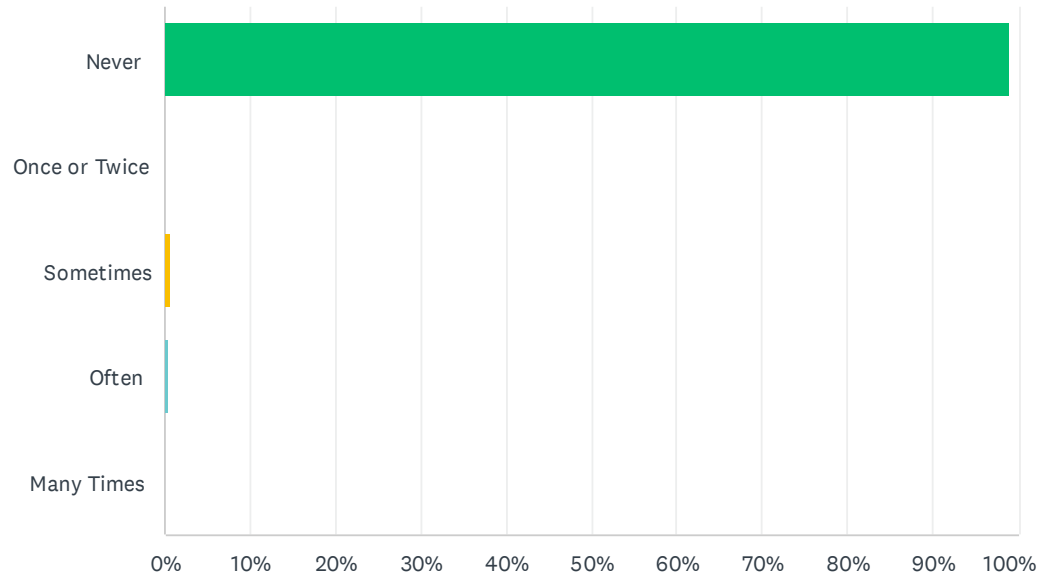

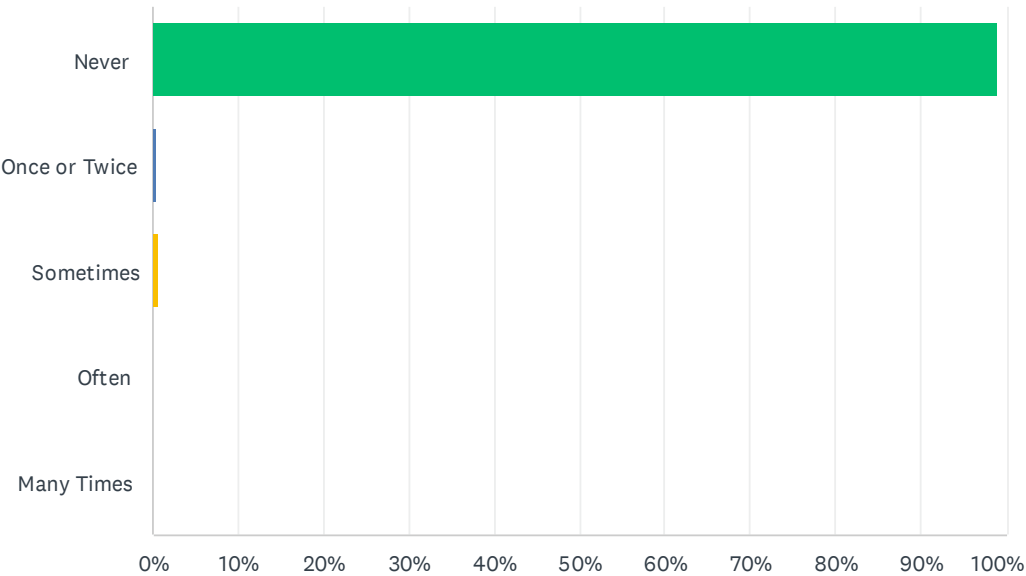

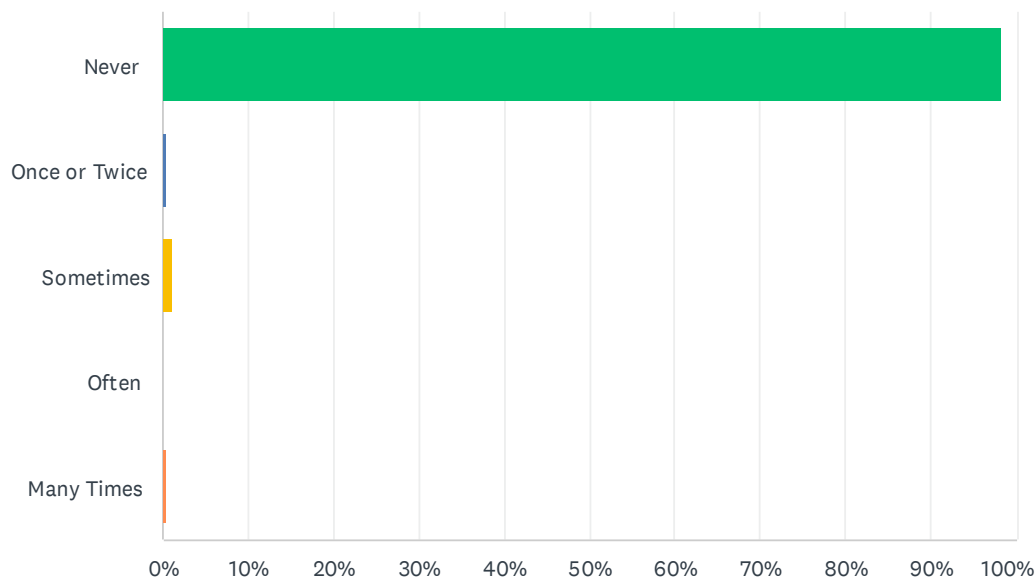

Q40 Implied better treatment if you were sexually cooperative?

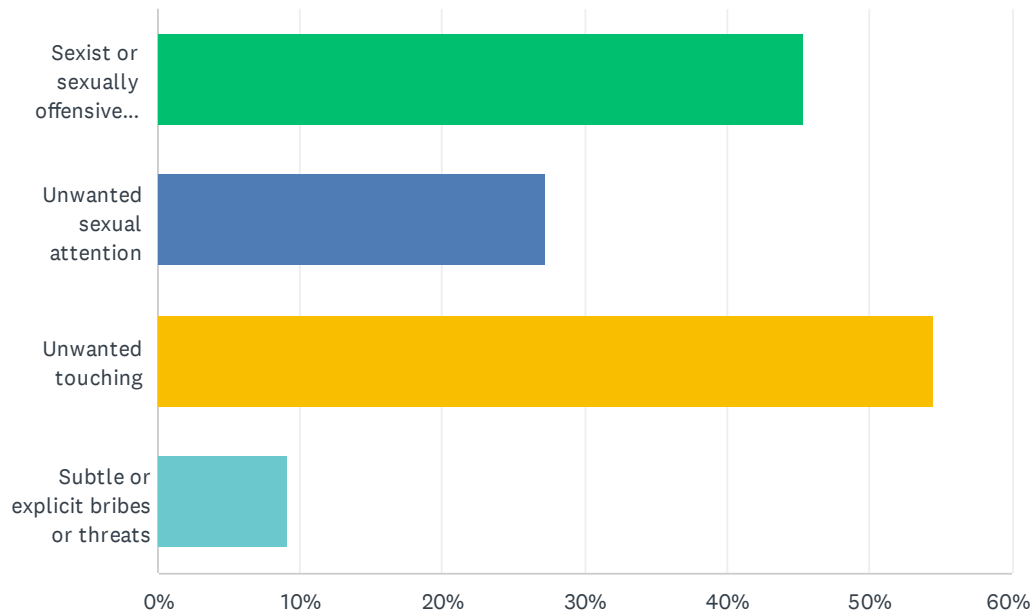

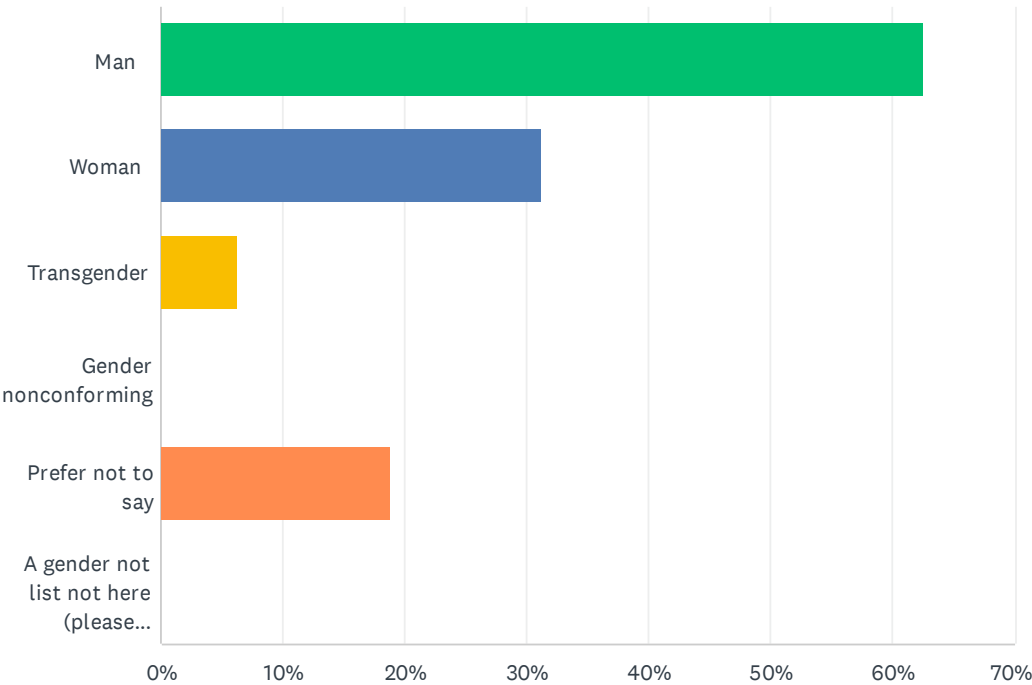

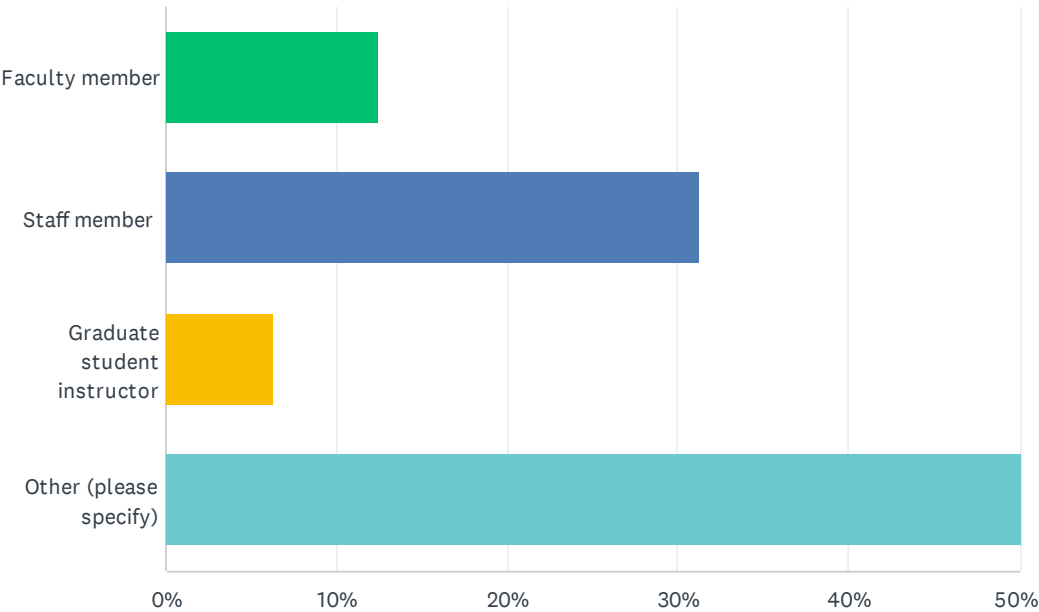

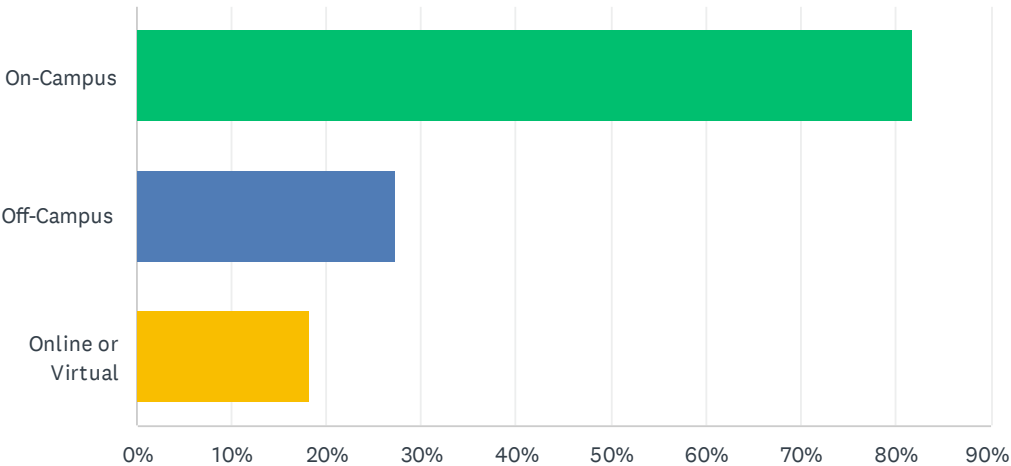

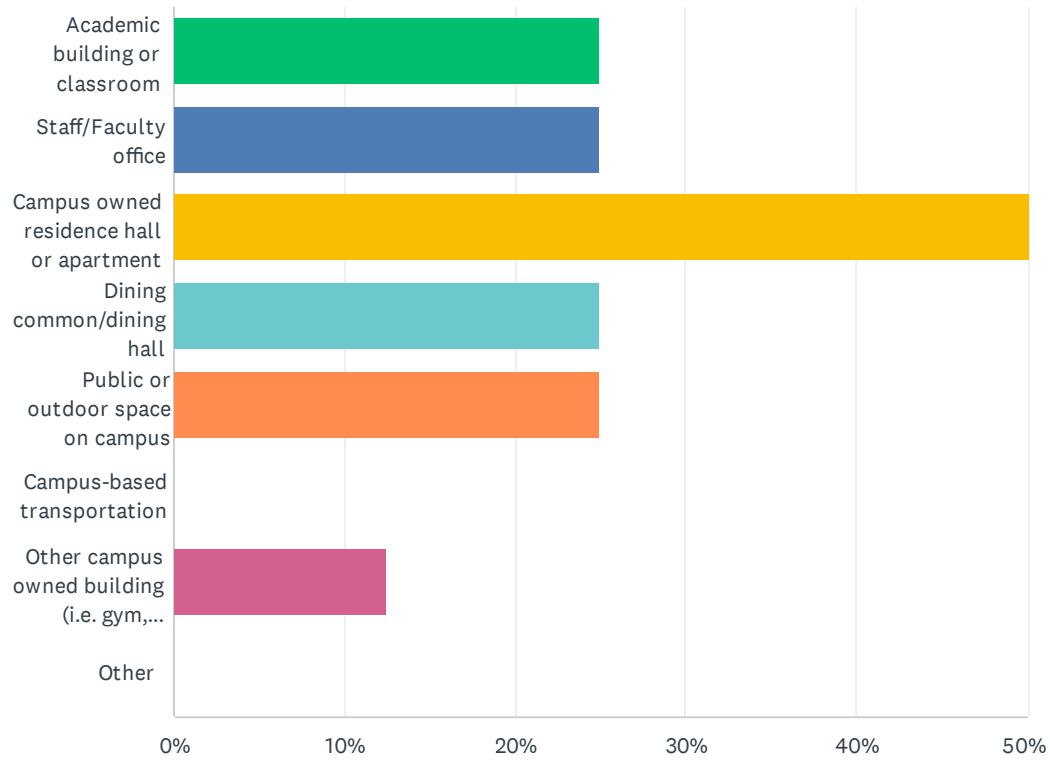

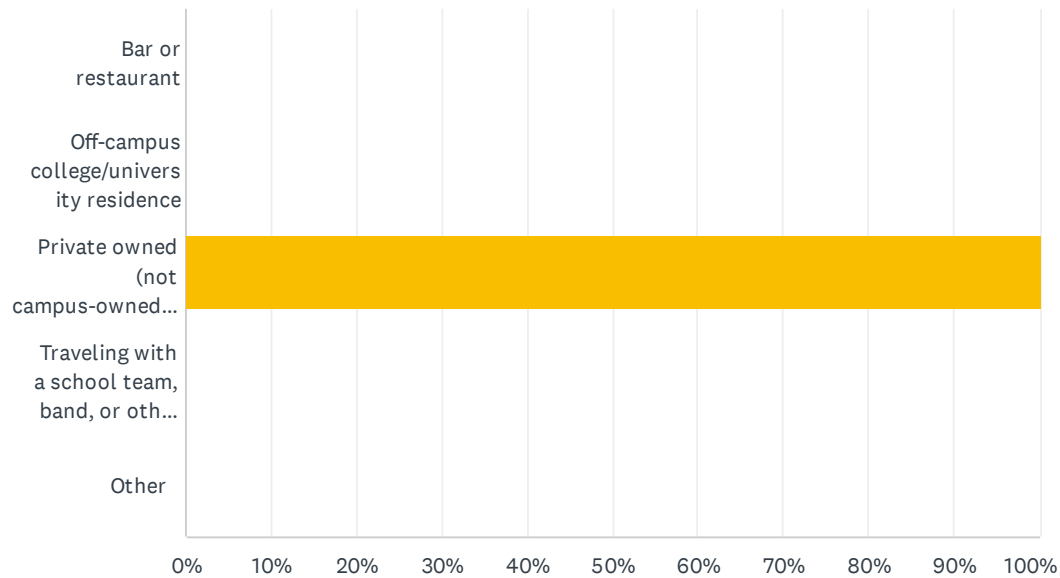

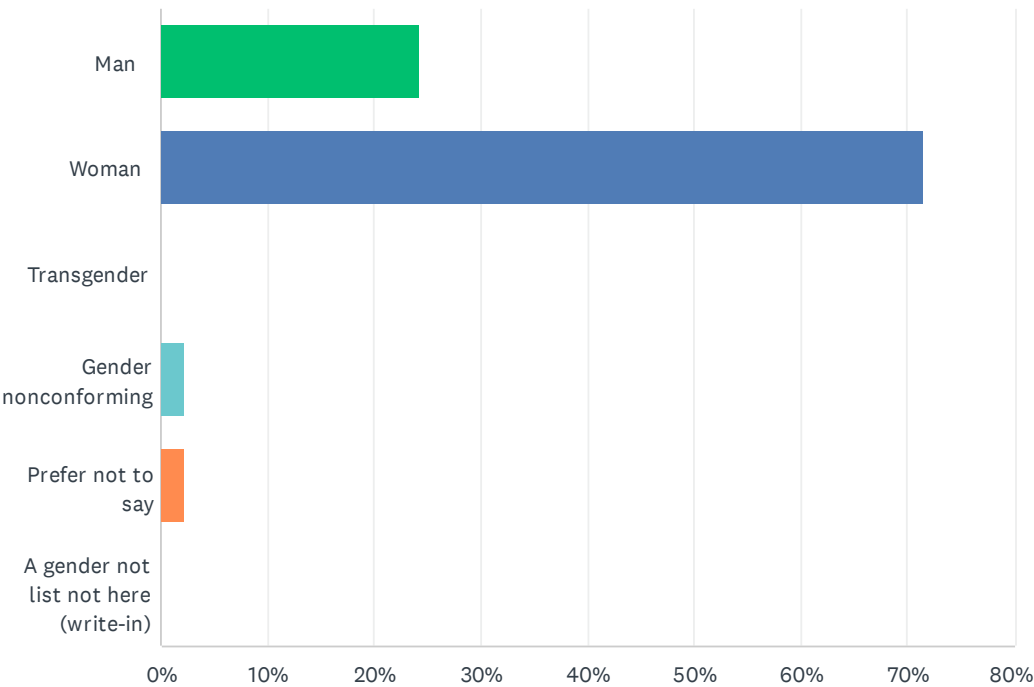
