Build Your Knowledge Base

Rivier's 4+1 program allows you to complete a B.S. in Marketing, Business Management, Finance, or Sport Management in your first four years and apply for the one-year MBA in your senior year. Coursework and projects ground you in quantitative and qualitative analysis and incorporate applications-based learning using new technologies, global perspectives, and ethics-based best practices. The one-year MBA provides advanced knowledge in financial management and addresses marketing and new product development, project management, economic analysis, strategies for innovation, and more.

Gain Real-World Experience

The curriculums focus on experiential learning, having you apply what you've learned to real-world situations. As a Business undergraduate, you're required to complete one career-focused internship and encouraged to participate in others. Students often intern in sales, financial planning, sport, and marketing organizations. Internships provide practical experience that builds your confidence and your resume. Study abroad opportunities, clubs, and co-curricular events offer learning and leadership experiences outside of the classroom.
