Executive Summary

Survey Administration

In the spring of 2022, Rivier University administered the campus climate survey that was provided to the school as required by NH RSA 188. The survey was conducted through Survey Monkey and sent to all students at Rivier. This was the first administration of this survey at Rivier University. The survey looked at the overall campus climate and issues of Gender-based violence including sexual harassment, stalking, dating violence and sexual violence. This survey had similar pieces to a climate survey administered in 2019 but overall was much different. The survey ran from February 8, 2022, through March 6, 2022. The survey was sent to 2,393 students with a 13.7% response rate.

Summary of Findings

The survey first asks all students about some of their perceptions, knowledge, and general experiences pertaining to sexual harassment, stalking, dating violence and sexual violence. A large majority of students who complete the survey said that they feel safe on campus from sexual harassment, stalking, dating violence, and sexual violence. Overall, students did not consider sexual misconduct being a problem at Rivier University. Students were relatively neutral on awareness of how to get help on campus for sexual misconduct, where to report sexual misconduct and what happens when a report is made. Students largely believed that Rivier University would take the report seriously, support the person making the report and take action to address the factors that may have led to the sexual misconduct.

The second part of the survey asks students about whether they had specific experiences relating to sexual harassment by a faculty, instructor or staff member, sexual harassment by a student, stalking victimization, dating violence victimization and sexual violence victimization. The rates for sexual harassment by a faculty, instructor, staff member, sexual harassment by a student, stalking, dating violence and sexual violence were higher in the current academic year (2021-2022) than any other academic year across all the categories.

Only a couple of students reported the incidents of sexual harassment, stalking, dating violence or sexual violence to a campus official. Most students had not told anyone about their experiences prior to the survey. The most common reasons for not sharing their experiences were it being a private matter or feeling as if it was not serious enough to talk about. Those who did share their experiences typically shared with a roommate or a close friend who was not a roommate.

Strengths and Challenges

One of the challenges identified by Rivier University is that this is the first year completing this survey therefore we do not have any comparison data. Rivier University has committed to raising awareness around the issues of sexual assault, domestic violence, dating violence and stalking through a grant provided by the Department of Justice, OVW. This grant has supported the CARE Program which has a full-time staff person dedicated to working to raise awareness here on campus.

One of the strengths of Rivier University is resources available to students. Overall, students said that they were aware of resources that were available to them including Counseling Services, Health Services and Campus Security. With students knowing that resources are available to our goal is that students will feel more comfortable coming forward if they experience any sexual misconduct issues.

Another strength identified in the survey is students acknowledge that the University has provided them with information about sexual misconduct. Most students said since coming to Rivier University they have received information regarding the definitions of types of sexual misconduct, and information regarding the student code of conduct. Rivier provides multiple trainings to students, including first year students, athletics, resident assistants, etc. through the CARE Project and the Department of Justice, OVW Grant.

Action Steps

1. Continued Awareness of Campus and Community Resources

Our goal at Rivier University is to make sure that all students feel safe and heard. One of the questions asked in the climate survey pertained to on and off campus resources and their relationship with sexual misconduct response. Students answered with a higher awareness to Campus Security, Health Services and Counseling Services. However, students' knowledge of Title IX and the CARE Project were much lower. Rivier University and the CARE Project will continue to provide educational material and opportunities to our students including first years, athletes, etc. about all our campus resources with a focus on the role of Title IX and the CARE Project.

2. Continued Awareness of What is Sexual Misconduct on Campus

Upon review of the campus climate survey, we noticed that students reported that incidents of sexual harassment, stalking, dating violence and sexual violence were happening here at Rivier University. However, our yearly Annual Security Report through the Jeanne Clery Act have shown us that students are not reporting these issues to the university. With continued education on sexual misconduct and what it entails we hope that it will help lower the number of incidents happening to Rivier students. It is our goal that through awareness students will feel more comfortable approaching the University if they experience sexual misconduct on or off campus.

Overview and Administration Details

Instrument: Under New Hampshire's RSA 188:H-4, Institutions of Higher Education must conduct a campus climate survey biennially. Rivier University was provided a "base survey" which was drafted by the task force. Rivier University did not append any of its own questions to the survey. The survey consisted of 10 modules containing a total of 246 questions.

Date Range: February 8, 2022, to March 6, 2022

Population: All degree-seeking students who were registered for Spring Semester classes at the time of the launch (total N = 2393)

Full-time equivalency: 1689

Distribution and Marketing: The survey was emailed to students' Rivier email address on February 8, 2022. Students got email reminders on February 15, 2022, February 22, 2022, and March 1, 2022. We asked that faculty, staff, and coaches to remind students about completing the survey and its importance. In addition, an announcement was created that students would see when accessing Canvas. Posters were hung in residents' halls and at other locations around campus which contained a QR code for students to scan and access the survey. A slideshow with the QR code was aired on a continuous

loop on the Dion Center television. Finally, Ryan Grogan, CARE Project Director, tabled and provided info sheets to students, with the QR code, during the survey window.


Survey response rate: 13.7% (327)


Percentage complete: 60.9% (199). Approximately 22% of students (72) responded to the questions in the first of ten modules but then stopped. Adjusting based on those who continued (255), the completion rate was 78%.










Q10 Been a very nervous person?


Q11 Felt so down in the dumps that nothing could cheer you up?



Q245 What best describes your gender identity? Check all that apply





Q246 Describe your race/ethnicity? Please check all that apply.



Q247 Are you an international student?







Q250 Since you've been a student at Rivier University, have you been a member or participated in any of the following? Please check all that apply.


