Rivier's Ed.S. in Counseling program will hone your critical thinking skills and provides an enhanced breadth of professional knowledge. For counselors working with specific populations, the program will help you develop greater expertise with those populations or gain exposure to new populations.

Our Ed.S. in Counseling program is designed for professionals who hold a master's degree in counseling, or a closely related field, and want to pursue further education and/or become certified school counselors. Graduates are prepared for a variety of leadership roles in clinical and educational settings.

Licensure, Partnerships, and Careers

Rivier has partnerships with schools, social service agencies, and counseling centers throughout the region, offering sites for internships and community service. You'll find our alumni working as school psychologists or counselors in public and private schools serving students in grades K-12. They are licensed mental health counselors in human service agencies and private practices.

Choose Rivier

Rivier's Ed.S. programs provide real-world assignments and handson experience in the field to help you put theory into practice and develop your skills. Courses are offered in 7-week or 14-week terms for added flexibility to accommodate your busy schedules and learning preferences. Upon completion of all program requirements, you will be eligible for school guidance counselor (K-12) certification by the New Hampshire State Department of Education. Becoming a credentialed counselor demonstrates expertise and leadership in this field.
