With a Master of Education in Early Childhood Education, you will develop the knowledge and skills necessary for teaching and leading in the 21st century.

Rivier's M.Ed. in Early Childhood Education degree offers two options based on your career goals: Administration or Teaching. The Administration option prepares you for a variety of roles in early childhood education and leads to a New Hampshire license as a child care program director. The Teaching option leads to New Hampshire teacher licensure. With this degree, you will be prepared to work effectively with colleagues, parents, and the community to help children receive the best possible education.

Available Facilities and Resources

Rivier University's Benoit Education Center houses the Cho Educational Resource Center, an extensive K-12 curriculum library, as well as an early childhood center. KinderCare at Rivier University offers students the chance to observe and work with children ages 6 weeks to 5 years.

Licensure

The M.Ed. in Early Childhood Education: Administration fulfills the NH Bureau of Child Care Licensing requirements and standards for director licensure. The M.Ed. in Early Childhood Education: Teaching prepares graduates for a NH K-3 teacher license; it is not automatic with the completion of the student teaching internship. Students must apply and be recommended for licensure after successfully completing all state and program requirements.

Accreditation

Rivier University is accredited by the New England Commission of Higher Education (NECHE). Education programs are approved by the N.H. Education Department, Division of Higher Education, Higher Education Commission.

M.Ed. Program Start Dates

Six term starts per year allow you to begin your program in September, October, January, March, May, or July. Completed applications are reviewed as they are received throughout the year.
